Qualifications:

- South Carolina resident
- Rising junior or senior majoring in accounting (or Master's Degree student) at a South Carolina college or university.
- GPA of no less than 3.25 overall (on a 4.0 scale).
- GPA in accounting of no less than 3.5 (on a 4.0 scale).

Completed applications and all attachments must be postmarked by June 1, 2010 for consideration.

Scholarships are awarded in July for the fall semester, and checks will be distributed by August 15, 2010 payable to the school. Scholarship recipients will be recognized at a special luncheon on in November as part of SCACPA's Annual Summit in Columbia. Amounts of scholarships usually range from \$500 to \$2,000. The amount to be awarded each year depends upon applicant qualifications and available funds.
