Stony Point FFA Booster Club SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

PURPOSE:

To identify those candidates who qualify for this scholarship and to establish some guidelines for those applicants as well as the Stony Point FFA Booster Club.

POLICY:

As a general rule this scholarship is available to seniors, who are members of the Stony Point FFA, with a desire to obtain a higher level of education. All applicants must meet all of the criteria set forth by the Stony Point FFA Booster Club.

CRITERIA:

- 1. Must be a graduating senior at Stony Point High School the year the scholarship is awarded to the recipient.
- 2. Must have been an FFA member for at least two years.
- 3. Scholarship applicants must be full time Round Rock ISD students for a minimum of one full semester, prior to the application deadline.
- 4. Application must be typed, using Times New Roman Font size 12.
- 5. A copy of applicant's transcript, including all college hours, must be submitted with application.
- 6. <u>Two sealed letters</u> of recommendation from Stony Point High School faculty (other than the Ag teachers) must be submitted with application.
- 7. Applicant must be prepared to write an essay on an assigned topic. Essays should be original works of the applicant and be a minimum of 250 words and a maximum of 500 words.
- Applications will be judged based on the following criteria: Scholarship (15 possible points); FFA Activities (88 possible points); School/Extracurricular (10 possible points); Special Recognition (10 possible points); Community Service (12 possible points); and Essay (15 possible points).
- 9. Application, transcript, and letters of recommendation must be submitted by the close of school (4:30 pm) on March 25, 2013 to Rachel Sotelo, Stony Point High School Main Office A127.

GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS:

- 1. The applicant's enrollment in an accredited institution (college, university, trade school, military academy, etc.) is a requirement for receiving scholarship funds.
- 2. Disbursement checks, including scholarship funds, shall be made payable to the college/university in the student's name.
- 3. Support for disbursement of funds shall include an invoice from the college/university.
- 4. Such funds will only be made available for one year after the scholarship is awarded.
- 5. Should the recipient fail to provide the Scholarship Committee a statement or bill from an approved educational institution within the one year period, the recipient will automatically forfeit the scholarship and the funds may be used to award future scholarships.

Applicants must carefully adhere to all application instructions. Failure to meet any of the aforementioned requirements will result in revocation of application and/or scholarship. All scholarship applications, which do not have the required information, will be considered incomplete and returned to the applicant.
