## **Prayer pointers**

During Lent we are called to pray for the projects being supported by our Bishop's Lent Call, focusing on different projects each week. We pray for the two projects in Peckham (Pecan and XLP) and for the church and people of Zimbabwe (details on the noticeboard). The people of Zimbabwe are full of hope and we can help them to realise their hopes when we give to the Lent Call, as the money that we give goes to help build skills and capacity in the areas of Zimbabwe where they are most needed.

Mental health trusts in England have seen their budgets fall by more than 8% in real terms over the course of this parliament, while referrals to community mental health teams, which help people avoid being admitted to hospital, have risen nearly 20%. Thousands of young people may be "slipping through the net" because adults do not spot the warning signs of mental health problems, experts warn. So we pray Father for our nation's mental health service clients, resources and staff. Bless Lambeth Hospital, Landor Road, its inpatients and those cared for in the neighbourhood. Amen.

We pray for our preparations for and journey through Holy Week, and especially for Canon Adrian Chatfield who will lead us on *The Walk* through it from Palm Sunday to Good Friday. Father, bless Adrian's and bless us as we walk with Jesus through Praise and betrayal, extravagance and duplicity, that we may arrive at Easter Day with our hearts, minds and wills renewed and blessed by you. Amen.

We pray for those who are unwell, for them to know your comfort and your peace. We pray for Lucy, Joel, Maylene, Betty, Sam, Pearl, Catherine, Becca, Antonia, and for the batients in Trinity Hospice.

We pray for all who mourn, that they may know the consolation of your love. We pray especially for the family of Carol Smalley, whose funeral was held here on Friday.
