Videotaping of any rehearsals and/or performances are strictly prohibited due to copyright laws. All Tech Week rehearsals are MANDATORY unless otherwise specified by the Director or Producer. Everyone cast in the show must log a minimum of 2 hours of set Building and Painting with the Producer. It is in the producer's final discretion as to whether your minimum amount has been filled.

#### Dear Parent/ Guardian;

My name is Alan Highe and I am the director of Spotlight Player's Production of "The Producer's" written by Mel Brooks. As a director of a Community theatre Production, I do not want to limit the younger community from auditioning for more risque shows, such as *The Producers*. After some deliberation with my Production crew, we have agreed that anyone the age of 15 years or older<sup>2</sup> may audition for this show. Due to the more mature nature of the show, I have decided to make anyone under the age of 18 provide a parent permission slip allowing them to audition for this show. After reading some of the more mature themes and innuendos listed in the show, please sign and date the portion below the dotted line. Then have your son/daughter attach it to their audition form.

There are three major parts that come off as particularly mature, offensive or extremely sexual in nature. The first situation is a song called "Along Came Bialy" which involves a line of Old Ladies insinuating that all they use Max Bialystock for is sex. Although the song is full of sexual suggestions, there will be no inappropriate choreography or physical altercations that suggest intimateness. The second song is called "Keep It Gay", where the term Gay is used as the definition of "Extremely Happy and Bright", although the character Rodger DeBris is a closeted Homosexual as listed in the character description. The final and most prominent scene is the musical within the musical "Springtime for Hitler". This number will feature swastika armbands, an actor dressed as Hitler, and many on stage references to the Nazi culture. I wish to inform all those auditioning that Spotlight Players shares no common viewpoints with the Nazi Party, and this show is to be taken as a Satire rather than a Political Advertisement.

#### **AUDITION REQUIREMENTS**

#### General Auditions:

Everyone auditioning for this show will have a couple of things to do at their auditions.

- 1.) Each person (depending on whom they audition for) will be taught a short dance about a minute to a minute in a half in length. This is purely to see how you move, and how quickly you can learn a dance.
- 2.) After each individual audition, the Production Crew will have a couple of questions for the auditionees. Please be prepared to answer questions regarding participation in the show, or anything on the audition form. (Note from the Director: A lot of people worry about this part. Don't! It's just for us to see a bit of your personality and to show you that we are not some scary monsters to be afraid of!)
- 3.) Before we split you up into groups, we will run each character song twice in groups before individual auditions begin.

## Leopold Bloom

1.) For all of those auditioning for Leo Bloom please prepare pickups to Measure 198-223 for *I Wanna Be A Producer* 

## **Max Bialystock**

1.) For all of those auditioning for Max Bialystock, please prepare Pickups to M. 121-153 of *King of Old Broadway* 

## Ulla Inga Hansen Benson Yonsen Tallen-Hallen Svaden-Svanson

- 1.) For all of those auditioning for Ulla, please prepare pickups to Measure 58-76 as well as Pickups to Measure 88-97 of *When You've Got It, Flaunt It!*
- 2.) When auditioning for Ulla, please keep in mind that she is an innocent (or so she seems) Swedish Girl. Although the Accent is not necessary at this time, we would like to see what you can do.

#### Franz Liebkind

- 1.) For all of those auditioning for Franz Liebkind, please prepare Pickups to Measure 6-20 of *In Old Bavaria*
- 2.) Those auditioning for Franz Liebkind will also be required to sing one of the Chorus songs. (Please see **Chorus** below).
- 3.) Please keep in mind that Franz is of German descent, a major nazi supporter, and is somewhat odd. Again, the accent isn't necessary, but if you have one, let's see what you can do!

    - i.) Anyone who wishes to be Shirley Markowitz, please sing one of the Chorus Songs.

- 1.) For those of you specifically auditioning for a chorus role, please prepare both of the following songs.
  - a.) Along Came Bialy
    - i.) Please prepare pickups to Measure 206-227
    - ii.) Males will be asked to sing this song twice, once regular and once Falsetto.
  - b.) It's Opening Night!
    - i.) Please prepare Pickups to Measure 50-73

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1.) What if I only want to dance in the show? Do I still have to come to auditions?
  - a.) Yes! *The Producers* is a large show that has many featured dance parts (Specifically in Tap Dancing). Once you come to auditions, you'll inform the production crew that you only wish to be a featured dancer.
- 2.) I can't make it to auditions, but still want to be in the show, is that possible?
  - a.) Yes! If you are not able to make it to auditions either the 20th or 21st, we will be accepting Video Auditions. You will be required to email the director (<u>AlanHighe0326@gmail.com</u>) to inquire about the information you must provide for the video auditions. The deadline for information inquiry is July 15th, and the deadline for video audition submissions is July 20th at 10PM. Please note, that all Video audition submissions will be watched after regular open auditions. Sending in a video audition does not deter your chances from being in the show.
- 3.) I've never been in a musical before. Could I still be in the show?
  - a.) There is a good chance. We are looking for not only talent, but for people who are willing to learn a part and really make it their own. However, if the stage simply isn't for you, we are still looking for Tech Positions. - 4.) What's provided with the \$35 membership fee?
  - a.) The \$35 membership fee allows you to audition and perform in any Spotlight Players show you are cast in, in the 2015-2016 Season. This also helps provide costumes, and materials for set pieces, as well as pay for the rights to bring great shows to the Plymouth/Canton area.
- 5.) I have a friend/family member that wants to help out backstage. Who do I have them contact?
  - a.) Have them contact the Producer, Sarah Osen at <a href="mailto:SarahGreen@live.com">SarahGreen@live.com</a> so she can inform them of what Tech Positions are available to be filled. Right now, we are looking to fill a variety of positions from Costuming, Light/Sound Design, Set Construction, and Backstage Help! Any and all help is appreciated!
- 6.) Will there be callbacks for the show?
  - a.) Only if necessary. The Production Crew would like to cast the musical based on the two days of auditions, but sometimes a hard decision comes along. At that point, Call-Backs will be held Tuesday July 21st from 9:00-10:00.
- 7.) When will the cast list be posted?

- a.) The cast list will be emailed to the cast and posted on the Facebook Audition Page, as well as SpotlightPlayersmi.org at 10AM on Wednesday July 22nd. At that time, we will ask that all cast members email the Production Crew informing us of their acceptance or denial of their role.
- 8.) Who do I contact about questions I may have about casting?
  - a.) Please direct all questions, comments or concerns regarding casting decisions to the Director, Alan Highe.
- 9.) What if I want to audition for more than one role? What songs do I sing?
  - a.) Please only sing for one character at auditions. It may be hard to make a decision but choose the character you would most like to audition for and sing for him/her. Then, in your individual auditions, please tell the Production Crew whom else you would be auditioning for.
