This year, we surpassed the total number of individuals, children and families served in 2011 by the beginning of October! We will not know the totals for 2012 until the end of this month, but we are going to exceed last year by almost 40%!! And even with an increase of services of this size we still have a waiting list for classes. This is huge because we have grown so much in the midst of significant cuts in our budget and with fewer staff. We must make up these gaps in our budget so that we can continue to grow our services and meet the needs of our community.

We are also proud of the new Passport to Employment program helping individuals build communication and job skills to enhance their work with job coaches and other employment services.

In 2013 we are looking forward to the start of our new health initiative: *Achieving Wellness*. We will focus on overall wellness and offer participants creative and fun ways to create healthier, more active and peaceful lifestyles. We'll do so with activities and weigh-ins on our new Wii Fit at the office, a new Weight Watchers group, nutrition classes, and a very exciting new partnership with TCU!! We are so excited to offer these awesome new opportunities for our consumers and to see a healthier 2013 and beyond!

While we are very excited about everything we've accomplished and hopeful about our future, we do need to increase our support and resources.
