Future maintenance of your door is based on the doors exposure to the elements. We have a great deal of confidence in the products we are using. Simply keeping your door clean will benefit you doors finish. Dirt and debris can build up on the doors which can give the elements something to stick too.

If the surface of the door is clean, snow, and water will run off and bead up rather than stick and keep the door wet. Polishing your door with wax or oil will also prolong the life of your finish. Always do a small test in an inconspicuous area on the door to make sure there is not an adverse reaction.
