**Eligibility:** Teachers must be employed by a school system and currently teaching in grades K-12 in the United States, and planning to continue to teach in the 2014-2015 school year.

## **Application Guidelines:**

- Scholarship application must be completed and submitted via e-mail by March 21, 2014.
- Applicants must reside or work in the county where they are submitting their application.
- Recipients will receive their conference registration and lodging in a double occupancy hotel room (\$800 value). Single occupancy hotel rooms are available, but the remaining balance will be the responsibility of the teacher.
- Transportation to Hershey will be provided at central meeting points across the state, courtesy of New York Agriculture in the Classroom.
- Meals not included in the conference program will be the responsibility of the teacher.

## Selection Criteria:

- Applicant describes in detail the importance of embedding agricultural literacy in their curriculum.
- Applicant communicates valid and unique reasons for why they want to attend the conference.
- Applicant explains how the experiences gained will be used after the conference.
