



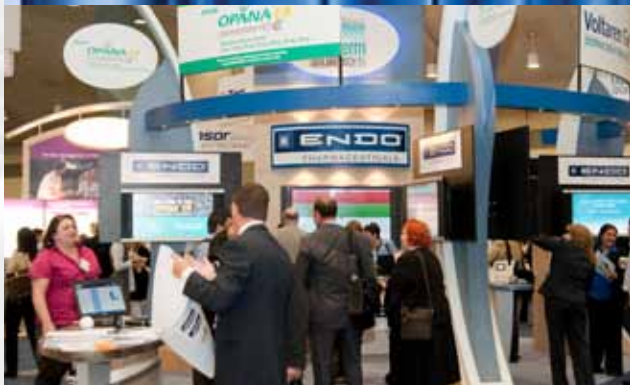

APS members are part of a large and diverse community of professionals from varied disciplines who work on behalf of people in pain through basic and clinical research and treatment, advocacy, and public policy.

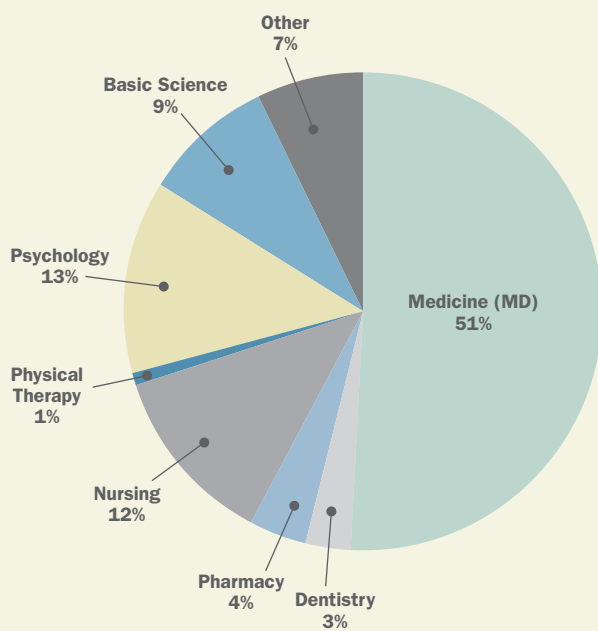

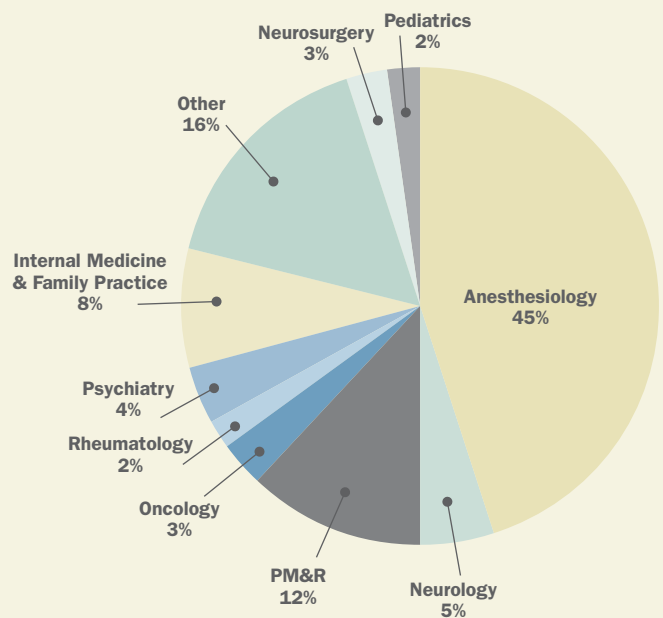
Founded in 1977, APS is a professional membership organization with more than 2,500 members and is a national chapter of the International Association for the Study of Pain (IASP).

APS envisions a world where pain prevention and relief are available to all people.

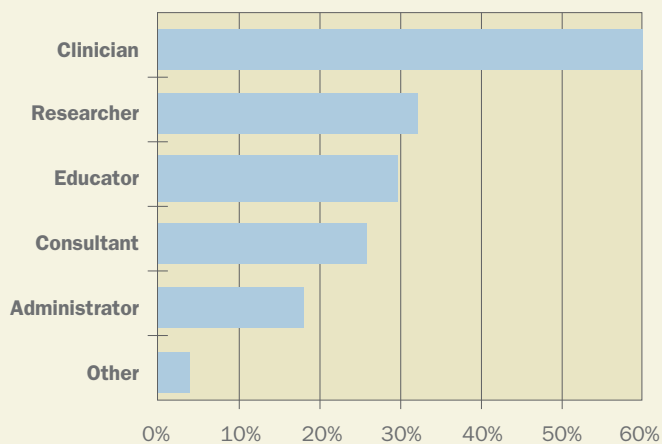
APS Members by Discipline



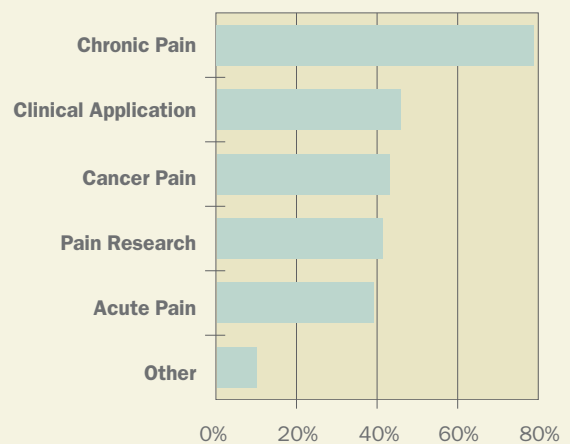
Physician Member Breakdown by Medical Specialty

APS Communications

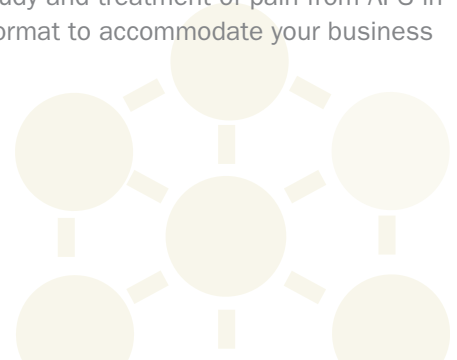
