**Entry Fees:** \$55 per competition (EA Levels), \$65 per competition (FEI Levels)

**National Young Rider Champions** will be awarded for the following levels: Preliminary, Preliminary Pony, Novice, Novice Pony, Elementary, Elementary Pony, Medium, Medium Pony, Advanced, Advanced Pony, FEI Small Tour (Prix St Georges/Intermediate I), FEI Small Tour Pony (Prix St Georges/Intermediate I), FEI Big Tour (Intermediate II/Young Rider Grand Prix)

**National Pony Champions** will be awarded for the following levels: Preliminary Pony, Novice Pony, Elementary Pony, Medium Pony, Advanced Pony, FEI Small Tour Pony (Prix St Georges/Intermediate I)

**Prizes:** Prize money or goods in kind will be awarded to the third place.

1st: \$75; 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$65; 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$55 (EA) 1st: \$85; 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$75; 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$65 (FEI)

Ribbons will be awarded to 8<sup>th</sup> place.

## Conditions of Entry

The 2013 EA Australian Young Rider and Pony Dressage Championships will be conducted in accordance with the current edition of EA Dressage Competition Rules effective 1/1/2013 including amendments. Competitors are to be aware of the Rules. The onus is on riders to know the rules under which they compete.

1. **Membership and Horse Registration: Riders and Horses/Ponies must be current members of EA**
2. **Australian Young Rider Championships - Age:** This event is open to riders 10 years and up to the end of the year they turn 21 on ponies or riders 12 years and up to the end of the year they turn 21 on horses.
3. **Australian Pony Championships - Age:** This event is open to all riders **10 years and over** on ponies only.
4. **Age Categories:** Competitions will be combined unless indicated, however ribbons or prizes may be awarded to different age groups depending on entries and sponsorship. Competitors can only ride in one category. Please indicate what category you would like to compete under, e.g. **CH:** Children from the year they reach 10 until the end of year they reach the age of 14; **JR:** Juniors from the year they reach 14 until the end of the year they reach the age of 18; **YR:** Young Riders from the calendar year they reach 16 until the end of the calendar year reach the age of 21.
5. **Height:** Horses – exceeding 149cm with shoes, 148cm without shoes, Ponies – not exceeding 149cm with shoes.
6. **Stallions:** Stallions are welcome to compete at this event however they must be kept under control by a competent person at all times when either ridden or led. Stallions must be led with a bit or chain in addition to their head collar. Stallions may not be tied to the outside of a truck or trailer but must be stabled or housed in a truck/trailer. Any stallion not considered to be in control by the Organising Committee (OC) will be withdrawn from the event. **Stallion Green Discs** must be displayed at all times on saddlecloths or halters.  
All riders and handlers are reminded that any horse can be dangerous so please give all horses and ponies enough room to pass safely whether you are leading or riding. Please be considerate of all riders and handlers and follow the rules of the arena whilst working horses; that is if you are walking stay towards the middle track in the arena, if you need to stop or check your gear move to the middle of the arena or leave the arena; pass riders coming in the opposite direction left shoulder to left shoulder. If you pass a rider in the same direction allow at least 5 m width. Please look around you at all times and try to be aware of others riding or walking past. Many people unintentionally frighten or distract horses by going too close or by moving too quickly; it is everyone's role to ensure the safety of others.
7. **Eligibility:** The qualifying period is the 12 months preceding the closing date of entries. i.e. 30/5/2012 to 31/5/2013. Please note performance must have been gained in **official competitions. No pony club or interschool performances will be accepted.** All entries for each competition must have qualified by having gained at least the following:
  - **Preliminary/Novice:** one performance of at least **62%**;
  - **Elementary:** one performance of at least **60%**;
  - **Medium/Advanced/FEI** one performance of at least **58% or higher is compulsory** at the level they are entering during the 12 months preceding the closing date. Only one HC score is allowed to count at each level entered.
  - **Horses/ponies entered in the EA Big Tour Entry Level test must have performance of 58% or more at Inter I level to be eligible to enter.**
8. **At least one qualifying score MUST have been obtained by the nominated horse/rider combination** (refer rule 8.2).
9. All riders must submit their horse's best three performances in an Official competition at the appropriate level, between 30/5/2012 to 31/5/2013. See above regarding the minimum performance requirement.
10. Horses or ponies may compete in **two (2) consecutive** levels. For example preliminary/novice; medium/advanced. They may compete in **three (3) tests only** per day, which may include a freestyle test.
11. **Ranking** (balloting) will be based on the average of the highest percentage of three tests at the particular level, in the 12 months preceding the close of entries. Riders who submit 3 performances (only one of which may be HC) will be considered ahead of those who submit one or two performances.
12. The number of horses per rider per competitions may be limited if oversubscribed.
13. **Draw:** Competitions are limited to 35 competitors. The OC reserves the right to rank horses if necessary. A revised draw may be necessary the day before the competition to allow for withdrawals. **The onus is on the competitor to confirm/check their start times the day before the competition.**
14. **Performance:** A print out from the EA web site of the horses results or a copy of the results sheet from the event showing your performance must be attached to your entries. All riders must submit their best three performances in an Official Test at the appropriate level during the qualifying period 30/5/2012 to 31/5/2013. See above for minimum performance requirement. If the result for a performance has not been entered on the performance card (e.g. an unplaced performance), then evidence (i.e. a copy of the official results sheet) must accompany the entry to substantiate the performance
15. **HC** entries will not be accepted.
16. **FEI Tests** can be downloaded at <http://www.fei.org/disciplines/officials-organisers/organisers/dressage/dressage-tests>
  - The FEI tests don't always align directly with EA levels however riders should be aware that they can only ride over 2 consecutive competition levels at any competition. For the purpose of competing at the Young Rider and Pony Championships the FEI tests are to be considered as below. Performance at the respective EA or PSG level is required:
    - i. FEI Young Rider - Prix St Georges Level
    - ii. FEI Pony – Elementary Level
    - iii. FEI Junior – Medium Level
17. **Saddlery and Equipment** As per current EA Dressage Rules 2013 including amendments. Note: EA levels up to and including advanced whips must not exceed 1.2m in its entirety. Approved hard hats must be worn at all times when training, warming up or competing at this event. Current safety approved headgear, AS/NZS 3838, EN 1384 (European) ASTN F1163 (US). PSG/FEI Competitions – top hats can be worn by riders 18 years and over in the final warm-up and during competition. A whip is not permitted in the FEI competitions.
18. **Bridle numbers** (Identification number) must be worn at all times when the horse is outside its stable. Please ensure you have two sets of numbers, one on the horse's bridle or saddlecloth for competition and one on the halter when taking horse out of the stable for walking/hosing down etc. Please include your allocated bridle number on the entry form. In the case of duplication of numbers, the OC will allocate a temporary # for this event only.
19. **Entry Forms** must be correctly and fully completed. Any mistakes or incomplete information will result in the entry form not being accepted and returned for correction. **Late entries, faxed entries and phone entries will not be accepted.** Be sure to enter on your entry form your three best performances at each level entered.
20. **Scratchings and Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 24 hours of the completion of the event. In such cases, 50% of the entry fees will be retained by the O.C. Entry fees will be refunded in full for scratchings before the closing date and for riders on the reserve list who are not offered a start in a competition. The administration fee will **not be refunded.**
21. **Sampling procedure for Prohibited** Horses/ponies will be subject to sampling for Prohibited Substances. Please ensure you have your horse registrations paper with you and cooperative with Officials if your horse/pony is selected for swabbing.
22. **Indemnity:** Riders and/or owners whose entries have been accepted, undertake to indemnify the Committee against all claims, losses, suits and damages made against or suffered by the Committee by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any riders, trainers or attendants whilst they are attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse and agree that any act or omission on the part of such riders or attendants found in any action against the Committee to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity. Riders are required to sign the Declaration form included on the entry

### Young Rider NSW Scholarship – open to NSW Riders ONLY

- a. Please download information in regards to the scholarship from [www.dressagensw.com.au](http://www.dressagensw.com.au). All riders entering the scholarship must forward their Scholarship Booklets and Sponsorship cheque with their entries.
- b. 10 winners will be chosen from the class: 4 riders 15 & under and 4 riders 16 to 21 years will be chosen. The other 2 winners will be the highest placed riders regardless of age.
- c. All riders must wear hacking attire and hard hats (not top hat or tails) all horses or ponies must be ridden in a snaffle bridle.
- d. The test to be ridden can be downloaded from [www.dressagensw.com.au](http://www.dressagensw.com.au).
- e. After the test another judge will ask you to comment on your performance. Expect to be asked what you thought were the good parts of the test & what areas you need to work on for a better test next time.
- f. Presentation of horse & rider plus the cleanliness & fit of your Saddlery will also be judged.
- g. The 10 finalists will be attending a 3-day clinic details to be advised. DNSW & the sponsors in the Scholarship scheme will meet instruction & arena costs

### General Information

1. **No Callers:** as this is a championship event **NO callers** are allowed.
2. **Dogs** – SIEC is located within a Regional Park under the control of the National Parks and Wildlife Service, and **dogs must be on a leash at all times**. No dangerous dogs please.
3. **Presentations:** will take place **at the end of the day or at the completion of each competition** (depending on the daily schedule). A presentation schedule will be posted on the Rider's Retreat notice board at the start of the championships. It is compulsory for all placegetters to be present at prize giving.
4. **Stabling:** Tying up of horses to floats and trucks at the venue designated areas only. For safety reasons, we recommend that competitors book a stable for their horses especially stallions. All stables will be empty on arrival and must be completely cleaned out on departure.
5. **Stable Enquiries:** Please direct stable enquires to Karen Lever via email: [dnsw.clarendonsec@equestrian.org.au](mailto:dnsw.clarendonsec@equestrian.org.au)
6. **Arrival of Horses:** S.I.E.C. will be open for arrival of horses from **Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July, from 1pm. No arrivals before this time**. On other days, please plan your arrival between **8am and 5pm**. Exception for day parkers who have an early draw. Please note the approx. time of arrival of horses on the entry form.
7. There is **NO** compulsory stable bond. **However, if stables and tack rooms are not left completely empty and swept clean competitors will be charged a \$75 cleaning fee**. All stables must be inspected prior to departure by the stable manager for a "clean pass"; competitors wishing to pay the cleaning bond can do so at the Rider Info Office or pay with their entry on the entry form.
8. **Tack Rooms:** If sufficient stables are available, competitors wishing to have their own tack room can request one at a cost of **\$27.50 per day**. Please indicate request and include payment on entry form. Please sweep clean on departure, if tack rooms are not left completely clean, competitions will be charged a \$75 cleaning fee.
9. Failure to pay stable/tack room cleaning fee post event will result in entries not being accepted in the future for any events conducted by Dressage NSW.
10. **Please Note: Charges for stable hire at SIEC apply to use of stables per day or part thereof. E.g. From midnight to midnight.** If you arrive before midnight on one day and leave at 6am the following day this is classed as 2 days. Please take this into account when booking stables.
11. **Bedding** (shavings) is not provided and orders can be ordered on the entry form. Competitors can either bring their own bedding (rice hulls or shavings) or shavings can be purchased with your entry. Please note that the average number of bales required to fill a stable is 6 to 8. We urge all riders to place your order for shavings with your entry or you may miss out.
12. **Day Parking Fee: A day parking fee of \$12 per day applies to all horses or ponies that are not stabled.**
13. **Stables not booked by the 24<sup>th</sup> June will incur a \$40 late booking fee per stable**
14. **Fodder:** Leppington Feed Supplies, Tel: 02 9606 5427 Fax: 02 9606 5736. Orders must be placed the day before delivery is required and all orders must be pre-paid. Please notify Feed Merchant of your stable number for deliveries.
15. **SMOKING is not permitted in the stables!** Only vehicles used by Stable Manager, venue staff and powered mobility for riders with a disability such as electric wheelchairs and powered scooters are allowed. Prams, bicycles, scooters and golf buggies not permitted in the stable area. Children must be supervised at all times.
16. **Camping facilities:** These are available on the grounds at a cost of **\$27.50 per night**. All sites are powered. There are good shower and toilet facilities with hot and cold water for males and females. Preferred sites (eg. nearest the stables) will be allocated firstly to competitors staying for the longer periods. Please note: horses or ponies are not permitted within the Camping Area.
17. **Cabin Accommodation on grounds:** Small cabins are available for hire at a cost of **\$55 per night** per room. Rooms contain 2 bunk beds with mattress, small hanging cupboard, 2 chairs, wall heater, power point and lights - linen is not provided. Rooms must be left clean and tidy and no cooking in rooms. A "Riders Retreat" with cooking, BBQ, TV, Video facilities is available for competitors to use during event.

21. **Catering facilities** - will be available on the grounds from Wednesday morning. Breakfast, morning and afternoon tea and lunch.
22. **Warming-up/ Exercising:** All riders must wear an approved safety helmet while mounted. *You are reminded that only the rider entered in the championships is allowed to ride the horse*. A groom may ride the horse at a walk on a long rein only. All horses must be saddled and be ridden in a bridle during any mounted exercise or competition warm-up. Please do not ride in the camping area. Note all horses must wear their bridle number when out of the stable. Outdoor arenas will be available for use prior to the competition. More information will be contained in the entry information which will be sent to riders. Competitors will have access to competition arenas for familiarisation.
23. **Bridle numbers** (Identification number) must be worn at all times when the horse is outside its stable. Please ensure you have two sets of numbers, one on the horse's bridle or saddlecloth for competition and one on the halter when taking horse out of the stable for walking/hosing down etc. Please include your allocated bridle number on the entry form. In the case of duplication of numbers, the OC will allocate a temporary # for this event only.

24. **Gear check:** All riders must check the EA rules for saddlery and equipment. A gear check is required before every test. Please arrive at least 10 minutes before you are due to ride. Monkey Grips are allowed. Whips must be no longer than 1.2m in its entirety including the cracker. *Gloves must be worn.*
25. **Lunging:** Lunging is only permitted in the lunge areas adjacent to the stable block, under no circumstances are horses to be lunged in any other area.
26. **Dress & headgear:** As per current rules, section 2: Approved hard hats must be worn at all times when training, warming up or competing at this event. Current safety approved headgear, AS/NZS 3838, EN 1384 (European) ASTN F1163. PSG/FEI Competitions – top hats can be worn by riders 18 years and over.
27. **Champion/Reserve:** Champion and Reserve for each level will be determined by using EA Dressage rule 3.19.

**Volunteers: Please note all riders will be given jobs to do during the event, which will include, pencilling, gear checking, test sheet collecting. There will be a job list on the web before the event. You will need to make sure that you are aware of your jobs before the event; jobs will be allocated around rider times in the draw.**

#### Conditions particular to entries in Freestyle competitions

1. **Participation in the Freestyle competitions may be limited depending on time constraints.** Participation will be determined by performances submitted at the corresponding level at the time of entry.
2. **Competition 28:** Grand Prix Freestyle: Competitors must score 55% or more in the Grand Prix at this event to be eligible to compete in the GP Freestyle.
3. Only the movements up to and included in the current tests at the level being ridden may be shown
4. Music must be supplied on CD with any relevant instructions attached in writing. **Please clearly mark horse and rider name on the CD along with any special instructions.**
5. There are certain movements that are compulsory for each level of Freestyle. Please check the EA rule book for these movements. Time Allowed – please refer to specific freestyle test sheets
6. Costume dress is optional. However boots and approved safety helmet must be worn
7. Equality of scores: If two competitors receive the same final score, the one with the highest marks for artistic presentation is the leader.
8. Pas De Deux Competitions – competitors must ride at the level of the most inexperienced rider ie. If one rider is competing in Medium and the other in Novice, then the combination would compete at Novice level.
9. Special Sashes will be awarded to the winner of each freestyle competition.
