## TAWAS AREA EDUCATION FOUNDATION (TAEF) SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION SPRING 2013

### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Locate the scholarship information that applies to the college you wish to attend. Carefully check <u>all</u> eligibility requirements for the scholarships that apply to you, and your area of study. These requirements are often different for each scholarship award.
- 2. Page 6 of this packet lists the scholarships administered by the Tawas Area Education Foundation (T.A.E.F.). You may apply for multiple T.A.E.F scholarships on one form if you meet <u>each</u> eligibility requirement.
- 3. If you are applying for a "need-based" scholarship, you must provide a copy of your Student Aid Report (S.A.R.) by the March 26<sup>th</sup> deadline. [You receive this report by filling out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form, available at all high schools and colleges.] Fill out this form as soon as possible to receive the results by the deadline.

Applications using the TAEF FORM are due no later than MARCH 26<sup>TH</sup>.

T.A.E.F forms are available from the Tawas Area High School Counseling Office or the T.A.E.F Office, located within the Superintendent's Office and <u>must be submitted to the Counseling Office or the T.A.E.F Office as an application package by MARCH 26<sup>TH</sup>. The completed package must contain the following:</u>

- Letter of application
- Signed TAEF application
- Copies of high school transcripts and/or college transcripts if applicable (March 25th deadline for transcript preparation by counseling office)
- Letters of recommendation from 2 (two) people who will address your strengths, skills and any other information that should be taken into consideration by the Scholarship Committee in its review process. Note: Letters should be current, dated and signed. At least one of the letters must be from someone not affiliated with school. (You may want to provide them with a stamped, addressed envelope asking them to mail the letters directly to you. Give them ample time to respond so you can include the letters in your application packet by the March 26th deadline.)
- A copy of your S.A.R. (Student Aid Report). This is <u>ONLY</u> for scholarship applications with need-based eligibility requirements as noted in the Jensen Scholarship

### • ITEMS MUST BE STAPLED OR PAPER-CLIPPED, DO NOT PUT IN BINDER OR PROTECTIVE SHEETS •

Scholarships are determined on a competitive basis. In many cases, there is only one award for each scholarship. The college must show final acceptance for admission and a letter stating that the admission fee has been paid.
