Youth & Family Field Day Rules and Regulations August 27, 2016

Check-in: 8:15a.m. - 9:00a.m.

Event: 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

- There will be no charge for the day's activities, or for the food and beverage that will be supplied for participants. The Youth Field Day committee will provide all equipment and supplies.
- No participant shall be permitted to bring his/her own sporting equipment to the event.
- ➤ All participants must be accompanied by an adult; however, an adult can bring more than one participant to the event.
- ➤ All youth must be between 10 years old and 16 years old.
- All participants must be pre-registered for the event no later than August 25, 2016. Youth and families that have not submitted their pre-registration paperwork to the registration committee will not be allowed to participate in the event.
- All persons must sign-in at the registration table between 8:15a.m. and 9:00a.m. on the morning of the event. Participation in any activity is optional, not mandatory.
- Lunch will be served at 12:05 PM. All activities will be shut down for a 45 minute period, and will resume again at 12:50 PM.
- An adult guide will accompany each group of 10 participants. Each participant must stay with their designated group the entire day.
- ➤ Each activity area will have qualified instructors available to welcome each group and to provide an orientation and safety briefing. Once the group is presented to the instructor, the instructor will exercise control of the group under his/ her jurisdiction.

- > The goal of the Youth & Family Field Day is to let kids have fun while learning various outdoor skills. For safety reasons, no reckless or careless conduct will be tolerated. Individuals deemed as "unsafe" by event instructors will be disqualified from further event participation.
- All events and activities will be supervised and coached by qualified event instructors. Every precaution has been taken to insure the safety of participants, though accidents can still occur in even the safest and most structured of learning environments. All attendees participate in events at their own risk.
- > Trained Emergency Medical Technician (EMT's) will be on the grounds all day, in order to provide first aid or medical assistance should the need arise.
