

COACHING STAFF

Since the beginning of our camps, the single most important factor has been hiring outstanding coaches. The goal of Carolina Softball Camps is to provide each camper with the opportunity to improve her current skill level. In addition to the Tar Heel coaching staff and players, the camp will consist of collegiate players, outstanding NCAA, NAIA, junior college coaches, former LPFA players, and well respected high school coaches from the Carolina region and throughout the country. TAR HEEL SOFTBALL TRADITION

After earning a spot in the NCAA Tournament field in 2001 for the first time in program history, the Tar Heels have made post-season play a habit, reaching that landmark seven times in the last seven years. UNC won the 2001 ACC title and continues to challege for another, reaching the title game in 2002.

Since Donna J. Papa became the head coach in 1986, the Tar Heels have averaged more than 36 wins per season and have reached the 40-wins mark seven times. Papa has been named ACC Coach of the Year four times, most recently in 2008. Carolina has had six players named to the All-America team, four players named ACC Player of the Year, and two players named ACC Rookie of the Year.

THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA

The University of North Carolina was the first state university in the nation and was the only public university to award degrees in the 18th century. Steeped in tradition and history, UNC has come to be regarded as one of the nation's top public universities and among the top 30 academic institutions in the country.

Students come from all 100 countries in North Carolina as well as the other 49 states and more than 100 other countries make up a diverse student body. The 729 acre campus has been recognized as one of the most beautifully landscaped spots in the country, and Chapel Hill is known as the "perfect college town" by several publications including Sports Illustrated.

Carolina's athletic tradition is just as illustrious as the university's reputation. Carolina has won 35 National Championships and 247 ACC Tournament Titles. It helped start the careers of some of the greatest athletes to ever play their sports including Michael Jordan, Mia Hamm, BJ Surhoff, and Davis Love III.

PITCHING & CATCHING July 13 & 14

\$225 - Commuter Camp Only

Pitchers will be taught in-depth specifics of throwing pitches by UNC Pitching Coach, Beverly Smith and a staff of experienced pitching coaches. Learn drills that you can take home to develop or improve your rise, drop, curve and screwball. If you want to learn a new change-up, this is the camp for you! We recommend that pitchers have a strong base and understanding of pitching mechanics prior to attending.

Catchers will be taught by an experienced catching staff.

Instruction will include advanced techniques for blocking, throwing, framing, calling pitches and much more.

This 2-day camp (4 sessions total) is NOT AN OVERNIGHT CAMP. The fee includes tuition, full dining, professional medical attention, and a Nike Softball T-Shirt.

Check-in will occur from 1:30-2:30 on Monday, July 13th at the UNC Eugene G. Anderson Stadium. Camp will end at 4:30 on Tuesday, July 14th.



ADVANCED CAMP July 14—17

\$450 (or \$410 for commuters)

This is a camp for players who desire a higher level of instruction. Players will be divided into competitive teams for all sessions. Sessions will focus on team strategies as well as individual skill work beyond the basics. All sessions enable the players to learn and practice skills that are needed for success at the next level.



This camp is designed for girls in grades 9-12. It is recommended for campers enrolling in this camp to have played at least one season on a High School Varsity team or will be playing on your Varsity team next year.

This 4-day camp (8 sessions total) is geared toward girls in grades 9-12. The fee includes tuition, housing, full dining, professional medical attention, and a Nike Softball Camp t-shirt. Check-in will be held Tuesday, July 14 from 2-4 pm in Morrison Dorm. Camp ends at noon on Friday July 17th.

ALL SKILLS

July 20-23

\$420 (or \$380 for commuters)

Campers will be divided into competitve teams for all sessions. Coach Donna Papa and a staff of experienced college and high school coaches will instruct participants of all skill levels.

Fundamentals of the game will be emphasizedhitting, bunting, pitching, catching, infield and outfield play, base-running, and game competition. A conditioning training session is also offered. Demonstrations, drills, practice sessions and game competition are included in the session. The 8:1 camper ratio allows for more individualized instruction.

This camp is a 4-day camp (8 sessions) geared toward all skill levels and all positions for ages 10-18. Campers are divided by age and skill levels to provide the appropriate learning environment. The fee includes tuition, housing, full dining, professional medical attention, and a Nike Softball camp t-shirt. Check-in Monday, July 20th from 2-4 pm in Morrison Dorm. Camp ends at NOON on Thursday, July 23rd.

LIL HEELS

DONNA J. PAPA, UNC HEAD COACH

CAROLINA SOFTBALL COACHING STAFF

Donna J. Papa, head softball coach at North Carolina since 1986, has been the veritable architect of a Carolina softball program that ranks among the country's best - and keeps getting better. In fact, Papa led the Tar Heels, NCAA Tournament participants in seven of the last eight years, to a new school record for most wins in a season at Anderson Stadium. Under her tutelage, Carolina has etablished itself as a perennial top 25 program testimony that UNC competes at the highest levels on the field while excelling academically at one of the nation's top universities.

One of the 20 winningest coaches in NCAA history, Papa joined the 800-win club in 2007 as her team went 46-21. In her remarkable 25-year career, she has compiled a 839-4884 record, including a 889-500-5 record, including an 860-485-5 mark as head coach at Carolina.

During her tenure at UNC, Papa has led the Tar Heels to 20 winning seasons, including the last 10 in a row. The team earned its first NCAA Tournament bid in 2001 and has made returns to the field the past six years running. Carolina claimed the 2001 Atlantic Coast Conference Chmpionship and has played in the title game on two other occasions. Papa has been named ACC Coach of the Year three times - in 1996, 1998, 2000 and 2008.

BEVERLY SMITH, UNC ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

The 2009 season will mark Beverly Smith's 10th year as a coach at Carolina, her first as associate head coach, though her integral role in establishing the UNC softball program can hardly be summed up by a number. Smith's first contributions as a Tar Heel came on the field as a player, where her remarkable career from 1991-94 helped establish Carolina as a growing softball force. Since then, though, she has continued to make an impact on the program, including her current role as assistant/associate head coach, a post she has held since 2004. Smith works with the team's pitchers and catcher and also coordinates recruiting. From 1998-2002, Smith served as an assistant coach at UNC, helping lead the 2001 Carolina squad to its first Atlantic Coast Conference title and first NCAA Tournament appearance. Since rejoining the staff in 2004, the team has not failed to reach the NCAA tournament.

JANELLE BRENEMAN, UNC ASSISTANT COACH

Janelle Breneman is in her fifth season as an assistant coach at Carolina. Formerly the head coach at Bucknell University, Breneman assists with the Tar Heels offense and oversees the UNC infielders. In 2008, Carolina had the top ranked defense in the ACC and were ranked eighth in the nation. Breneman along with the Carolina softball players have been selected in 2006 and 2007 to serve as NCAA YES Softball Clinic clinicians at the College World Series in Oklahoma City, OK. At Bucknell, Breneman was the 2004 Patriot League Coach of the Year after leading the Bison to the conference tournament for the first time since 2000. Prior to her successful run at Bucknell, Breneman spent five years as the head coach at Division II East Stroudsburg University. Breneman was a Divison II All-America at shortstop and a three-time All-PSAC first team selection while earning a bachelor's degree in adult health/cardiac rehab. Following her collegiate career, she played two seasons for the Georgia Pride of the Women's Professional Fastpitch softball league, starting at shortstop and second base. In the fall of 2006, Breneman was inducted into the Bloomsburg University Athletic Hall of Fame.
