Eligibility:

This certificate is available to students pursuing an undergraduate degree within Mays Business School. See undergrad catalog for course prerequisites. All requirements must be met prior to graduation

Requirements

- 1. **Submit an Application of Intent**: The Application is a simple information form stating your intent to complete the certificate requirements. *Form available in Wehner 430*.
- 2. **Academic Coursework**: The Certificate requires a total of 13 hours of coursework, including a 1 hour entrepreneurial internship that you *must* arrange through the Center for New Ventures and Entrepreneurship.
- 3.**Submit an Application of Completion:** This form is much like the Application of Intent. It will detail the courses you have completed and officially submits the adding of the certification to your transcript. *Form available in Wehner 430*

The Certificate is designed to develop the competencies needed to successfully create and manage new ventures or to be a driver of innovation within existing enterprises.

Emphasis is placed on leadership in three areas: conceiving, exploiting and managing opportunities.
