I know the traditional people of the Association will cherish their original 75 SQN tie and perhaps think that there should never be another ... I had an original tie by Eskay, but have for some time dreamed up a concept of a tie that gives each of us an opportunity to identify our own piece of 75 SQN history.

A friend of mine in Levin has worked on creating the left hand side elevation views of the eight aircraft types that 75 SQN (NZ) RAF and RNZAF flew from 1940 to 2001. These are also being featured on a new Sqn Lanyard and Prints on A3 white framing paper to hopefully be available at the Reunion.

I decided that we would feature the following as having some historical value to all or some of us ...

Wellington 1C,

R-AA: L7817 James Ward VC, the aircraft Ward went 'wing-walking' on one night!

Stirling,

AA-U: BK777, "Alexander's Rag Time Crew". Alan Alexander DFC, flew this for a tour. Lives in Waikanae.

Lancaster,

JN-M: NE181. "The Captains Fancy". The only Lancaster to have completed 100 + Ops on 75(NZ).

Lincoln, AA -A: RF389. 75(NZ) only received three Lincoln's before VJ day. W/C Baigent buzzed the ship taking 75er's home in AA-A.

Mosquito, Y-YC. This one was saved from a farm in the South Island and is being restored at Ferrymead in Christchurch.

Vampire FB5, NZ5770. On display at the Southwards Car Museum near Paraparaumu.

Canberra B2, WK102. On loan RAF a/c at Tengah.

Skyhawk A4K, Brown with hump, NZ6206. In 1976, Sqn Ldr Jennings shot across the bows of the trawler Kin Nan in '06.

Skyhawk A4K, Green without hump, NZ6205. The last single seater to be flown by the RNZAF.

I have enclosed a form for you to order 'your' tie with if you would like one. Select the era from which you were on the Squadron, and the aircraft type which you flew in or flew as aircrew or worked on them on the ground.

Indicate on the Slip the **era** by number and **aircraft** by letter (or letters if more than one), cut off the slip and post back to me with a cheque - **include postage of \$4.50** if you want me to post them back to you....

There is an order going in very soon to ensure people have their tie for the reunion. So cut off for that is by end of first week of March. If you can wait a while, then I'll add it to another order later in April.
