HUNTERS WINGSHOOTING CLINIC INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS

DATES AND TIMES: Saturday & Sunday, August 23-24, 2014

Morning Sessions: Check-in time 7:30-8:00 a.m. Afternoon Sessions: Check-in time 12:30-1:00 p.m. Instruction & Shooting 8 a.m. - 12 noon Instruction & Shooting 1 p.m. - 5 p.m.

LOCATION: Decatur Gun Club, Decatur, IL (217/855-1027).

DIRECTIONS: From I-72 take exit 144. Turn southwest onto IL Route 48 towards Decatur. Next, turn left onto Brush College Road. Proceed 1³/₄ miles to the intersection of Brush College Rd. and Reas Bridge Road, then turn left onto Reas Bridge Rd. Proceed 1 mile, then turn right onto Christmas Tree Lane. Next, turn left at the Decatur Gun Club entrance sign.

COST: The fee for each session is **\$35** per person. **The fee is not refundable.** To secure your reservation, send a check payable to the <u>Decatur Gun Club</u> and appropriate completed forms to the address provided below. APPAREL: Wear upper garments that do not restrict either side-to-side shoulder movement or up and down arm movement. Upper garments should not have snaps, buckles, buttons, or strap adjustments on the front side of the shooting shoulder. Bring a shooting or hunting vest or a shotshell pouch if one is available.

FOOTWEAR: Wingshooting instruction and shotgun shooting are field activities. Wear comfortable but sturdy shoes or boots.

EYE & EAR PROTECTION: Eye and ear protection are mandatory. Participants are expected to provide their own shooting glasses and ear plugs or ear muffs. Participants who wear prescription glasses or contact lenses should wear them. Impact resistant safety glasses are required to be worn over prescription glasses if the prescription glasses are not impact resistant. Safety glasses must be worn in addition to contact lenses.

SHOTGUNS & SHOTSHELLS: Bring a field, sporting clays, or skeet shotgun that you're comfortable shooting - any reasonable gauge (410 and 10 gauges are not reasonable). Open chokes are preferable - skeet, improved cylinder, or light modified are sufficient. Bring six - eight boxes or 150 - 200 target shotshells. Target loads in 12 gauge have a 2³/₄ or 3 dram powder equivalency. Higher powder dram equivalencies will adversely impact your shoulder. Shot sizes of 7 ¹/₂, 8, or 9 only please.

INSTRUCTORS: Wingshooting instruction will be provided by National Sporting Clays Association/IDNR Certified Wingshooting Instructors.

SPONSORS: This Hunters Wingshooting Clinic is sponsored by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, the Illinois Conservation Foundation, and the Decatur Gun Club. The IDNR has been involved in training sportsmen and women through its Safety Education Section, by sponsoring wingshooting clinics, through youth hunting programs, and through hunter skills programs for many years. The Decatur Gun Club supports young shooters through its sponsorship of an SCTP Shooting Team and co-sponsors the Decatur Gun Club Youth/Women's Wingshooting Clinic in September each year.

SPECIAL NOTES: The Department of Natural Resources or the Wingshooting Instructor will have any participant removed from the Wingshooting Clinic for disruptive or unsafe behavior. Wingshooting Clinics do not satisfy the Illinois Hunter Education Requirement.
