Dr. James Garbarino is the Maude C. Clarke Chair in Humanistic Psychology at Loyola University Chicago. Dr. Garbarino has invested his career studying a wide range of issues related to children and violence; war, child maltreatment, childhood aggression, and juvenile delinquency. Dr. Garbarino is a nationally known speaker and has authored many books, including: Children and the Dark Side of Human Experience; See Jane Hit: Why Girls Are Growing More Violent and What We Can Do About It; And Words Can Hurt Forever; Parents Under Siege; and Lost Boys: Why Our Sons Turn Violent and How We Can Save Them. Dr. Garbarino will be presenting on the impact of family violence and how we can effectively respond to violence perpetrated by youth within their families.
