DONATIONS

CNSC continues to be blessed with some wonderful donations in 2015. Here are some of the examples of generosity. Each year for the last several years, for example, we can count on a monthly fixed donation of \$25, a weekly fixed donation of \$100, a monthly percentage of a paycheck tithe, a quarterly check for \$125, a yearly distribution from the Montana Community Foundation (interest from an account Joyce Longpre had CNSC start many years ago), a \$10,000 donation from Pavlik Electric Company, a business who donates 10% of proceeds for the month of July, Bina & Tom Eggensperger for printing all our posters and tickets, and Randy Garrison at The Printery who donates the printing costs for our Newsletter. Then we have the 'special event' donations - ones we didn't plan on, but nonetheless add greatly to our financial status like the proceeds from a concert brought to you by Jan and Don Manning, Plains and Thompson Falls Volleyball teams, Noxon Community Services Fellowship, Inc., and the Noxon Student Fund Association. Those of you who count yourselves in this bracket of donation and ask to be anonymous, we thank you from the bottom of our hearts. It can't be stressed enough that we have to have a basis of funding we can count on. Special donations, again from folks who do not want to have their names used, totaled around \$30,000!
