The Round Rock TAG Association will hold its next general meeting on Tuesday, February 27th from 6:30 pm until 8:30 pm in the lecture hall at Cedar Valley Middle School.

The meeting's topics will include:

- a presentation by Abacus Brain Study, which has been helping children in Austin build better memory, deep concentration, great discipline, strong self confidence, and higher learning skills for the past 4 years. Optimize your child's brain development through a relatively simple mental brain exercise program. Bring your kids and challenge the abacus students during the presentation time;
- a presentation by Meredith Denton-Hedrick regarding the new Shawn and Kitanna Martin Memorial Scholarship Fund;

Changes to the RRTAGA Scholarships

The Round Rock TAG Association Board recently voted to make some significant changes to the scholarships we offer. In the past, we have offered four \$300 scholarships to graduating seniors, but we have received feedback that these scholarships were too small relative to the amount of work required.

The board voted to simplify the application for the senior scholarships, reduce the amount of writing required, and increase the award to \$500. However, because we have so few graduating seniors who are RRTAGA members, we have reduced the number of available scholarships to one.

The remaining money from the scholarship budget will go toward creating the new *Shawn and Kitanna Martin Memorial Scholarship Fund*. The entire Martin family recently lost their lives in a plane crash in Ohio at the onset of winter break. Kitanna was a TAG student at Great Oaks Elementary, and Shawn a TAG student at Cedar Valley Middle School. This fund will provide scholarships for RRISD's TAG summer enrichment camp to students who qualify. The Martin family was a very generous and caring family, and we feel this is a wonderful way to honor their memory, as well as better serve Round Rock ISD TAG students.
