# 2015 AHS-HRC College Scholarships

Sponsored by the Hampton Roads Chapter (HRC) of the American Helicopter Society (AHS)

#### **Purpose:**

These scholarships are intended to recognize and assist high school seniors who wish to pursue a college education leading to a career in engineering or related technical fields such as physics, mathematics, or computer science.

#### **Eligibility:**

High school seniors from the following Hampton Roads School Districts:

Chesapeake Gloucester Hampton Isle of Wight James City County Newport News Norfolk Portsmouth Poquoson Suffolk Virginia Beach Williamsburg York County Matthews

#### Award:

One or two scholarships will be awarded. The recipient(s) will receive a 1-year membership in AHS, an engraved plaque, and a \$2,000 scholarship.

### **Application Requirements and Weights:**

35% - Essay of 1 page (minimum) to 3 pages (maximum) addressing this topic: Tentative - What developing technologies will most affect rotorcraft in the next ten years? Write an essay that explains your position. Please note that a Plagiarism check will be performed on each essay.

30% - Scholastic achievement (GPA, high school transcript, and SAT score)

25% - Letters of reference, two letters minimum, written by faculty, school administrators, guidance counselors, coaches, pastors, youth ministers, work supervisors, band directors, scout leaders, and other people the applicant might choose.

10% - Leadership potential as demonstrated by extra-curricular activities

Note that, because the chapter typically receives a number of excellent applications, detailed attention should be paid to each of the above sections of the application.
