LHS PARKING REGULATIONS

You have many personal responsibilities when driving an automobile on the LHS campus, as well as responsibilities for the welfare of others. All drivers are expected to abide by the rules pertaining to the parking areas/LHS campus, in addition to those outlined by the Department of Public Safety.

1. All vehicles parked on campus must have a valid parking permit.
2. The parking permit MUST be placed in the lower right hand corner of your windshield (the passengers' side).
3. You may not allow another student to use your parking permit. If theft and use of another's parking permit is involved, the SRO may be called upon to investigate.
4. Student parking is in the EAST Parking lot only. Do NOT park in front of LHS or between the Gym and Tennis Courts or between the Cafeteria and Indoor Facility between the hours of 8:00am and 2:30pm.
5. Do not back into a parking space and have the car head the wrong direction. Park within the lines.
6. There is to be no parking where the curbs are painted red (fire lane).
7. Do not park in loading zones, visitor parking, handicapped parking, or teacher parking.
8. It is imperative that you not exceed the speed limit of 10 mph while driving on campus.
9. Students are to leave their automobiles and clear the parking lot as soon as they have parked their vehicle.
10. No student will be allowed to ride or be transported in the back of a pickup truck while on the LHS campus. The driver of the pickup will be assigned consequences.
11. **ANY** and **ALL** drugs, alcohol, drug paraphernalia, illegal weapons found in vehicles on the LHS campus will lead to a full year suspension of driving privileges for the owner/driver of the vehicle.
12. If you have received a violation, you may be asked to show proper ID – Driver's license and proof of insurance.
13. **At no time are students permitted in the parking lot during the school day without first getting permission from the AP secretaries (A110 or C200).**

CONSEQUENCES: I understand, if the above rules are not followed, the violation(s) may result in the following:

1. Discipline per discretion of the Principal/Ass't Principal (Saturday School, Detentions, ISS); and/or,
2. Parking privileges may be revoked; and/or,
3. Car being towed; and/or,
4. Citation
