REQUIREMENTS FOR IRREVOCABLE LETTER OF CREDIT

1. Must comply with the then required form of the Authority.
2. Issuer must be licensed to do business by the Banking Department of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or by the Treasury Department of the United States of America. (Resolution of April 2, 1998)
3. Place of presentation for payment shall be in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania at no greater distance than 100 air miles from the office of the Authority. (Resolution of April 2, 1998)
4. Place of presentation for payment must be open with normal banking hours set by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. (Resolution of April 2, 1998)

Gentlemen:

We ("Bank") herby issue our Irrevocable Letter of Credit in favor of the East Cocalico Township Authority (the "Authority") for any sum or sums not exceeding _____ Dollars (\$ _____) (hereinafter "Credit Amount") for the account of the above-named Applicant (hereinafter called "Developer").

This Letter of Credit pertains to the plan of _____, containing _____ lots, which was prepared on _____ by _____, Drawing Number _____, and which was submitted to East Cocalico Township on _____.

Intending to be legally bound, we herby agree that:

1. Written demands, in an aggregate amount not exceeding Credit Amount in the form attached hereto and marked Exhibit X (executed by one of the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary or Treasurer of the Authority), shall be duly honored at sight drawn at your option for payment to be made not later than ten (10) days after presentation at our office at _____, before the above Expiration Date.

2. The Expiration Date of this Letter of Credit shall be automatically extended without amendment for additional one (1) year periods beginning with Expiration Date and upon each anniversary of such date, unless at least thirty (30) days prior to such Expiration Date or each anniversary of such date the Bank notifies the Authority in writing, by delivery to its office or by certified mail, addressed to the Authority at the above address, that the Bank elects not to renew this Letter of Credit.

3. For each yearly period that this Letter of Credit is automatically extended beyond Expiration Date, the amount of this Letter of Credit shall be increased by an additional ten percent (10%) of the unused balance.

4. Payment under this Letter of Credit shall be made without determination by Bank of conditions or facts pertaining to related contractual agreements between Developer and Authority and without any approval of Developer.

5. Except as otherwise stated herein, this Letter of Credit is subject to the "Uniform Customs and Practice for Documentary Credits (2007 Revision), International Chamber of Commerce Publication No. 600".

6. If this credit expires during an interruption of business as described in Article 36 of said publication, the Bank specifically agrees to effect payment of any draft drawn on this credit within thirty (30) days after the resumption of our business.

7. This Letter of Credit will be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania only. All legal proceedings shall be in the Court of Common Pleas of Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, if possible. Any federal legal proceedings shall be heard in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, if possible, but shall be brought only in U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania.

Intending to be legally bound hereby, this Letter of Credit has been executed by a duly authorized officer of the undersigned Bank.
