1 See if you need to test:

Click on ALTERNATIVES TO TESTING for a list of approved testing exemptions. Students eligible for an exemption must submit Prerequisite Challenge Form A (available at sbcc.edu/prerequisitepolicy).



2 Choose a math test & review:

Click on SAMPLE TEST QUESTIONS to view practice math tests. Plan to take the highest numbered test that matches your math background and current skills. Math test study packets may be downloaded from the Assessment website or ordered from SBCC's Bookstore: sbccbooks.com. Online pretests for Math Test #3 and #4 are available at <http://mdtp.ucsd.edu/onlinetests.shtml>. Please note: calculators are not allowed. It is best to review without the aid of a calculator. To review the sample English test, click on SAMPLE TEST QUESTIONS.

3 Choose when you plan to test:

Click on DROP-IN TESTING HOURS to view the **monthly testing schedule** and plan to test on a scheduled testing day/time. No appointment is necessary for drop-in testing, but all tests must be completed by closing. If you live out of the area, click on SPECIAL INFORMATION FOR OUT-OF-AREA STUDENTS for additional testing options.

► After completing steps 1-3, mark the test(s) you plan to take:

- ☐ **ENGLISH Test: Requires 2 hours.** Tests reading, writing, and grammar skills for placement into English classes.
Note: the English Test includes an essay that you can choose to type or write by hand. All other parts of the English test taken in the drop-in computer lab are on computer. Students requesting a paper/pencil exam must make an appointment prior to testing. Please initial your choice: **Hand-Written Essay:** _____ **Typed Essay:** _____

- ☐ **English as a Second Language (ESL) Test:** For second language students who are not ready for the English test.

CHOOSE ONE MATH TEST: Requires 1-2 hours.

- ☐ **Test #1:** Tests arithmetic skills for placement into Basic Math, Pre-Algebra, or Elementary Algebra. **(1 hour)**
- ☐ **Test #2:** Tests 1st year Algebra skills for placement into Intermediate Algebra. **(1 hour)**
- ☐ **Test #3:** Tests 2nd year Algebra skills for placement into Statistics, College Algebra, or Pre-Calculus I. **(1 hour)**
- ☐ **Test #4:** Tests Pre-Calculus skills for placement into Pre-Calculus II or Calculus. **(2 hours)**
