2014 ABA/NLADA EQUAL JUSTICE CONFERENCE

Justice Scholarship

Purpose:

The Justice Scholarship Program gives people who, without financial assistance cannot afford to attend the 2014 ABA/NLADA Equal Justice Conference, an opportunity to participate. The purpose of the Justice Scholarship Program is to provide travel expense *assistance* to full-time pro bono program managers/staff and new lawyers participating in post-graduate public service fellowships (including Americorps lawyers) -- two groups that routinely have found it financially difficult to attend. Scholarships up to \$750 will be provided to help *reimburse* travel-related expenses for each recipient.

Eligibility:

To be eligible to receive a Justice Scholarship, applicants must:

- 1. be employed full-time as the director or a staff member of a pro bono program dedicated to providing free civil legal services to the poor or be a new lawyer participating in a post-graduate public service fellowship,
- 2. not have received a scholarship to attend the Equal Justice Conference within the past two years,
- 3. first seek and be denied full financial support from their program or organization before requesting a Justice Scholarship,
- 4. pay the conference registration fee, and
- 5. agree to submit a report and evaluation of the Equal Justice Conference by <u>June 13, 2014</u>, stating objectives for conference attendance, what was gained from attendance, and how this knowledge will be put to use in the person's work.

Preference will be given to pro bono program managers and staff who have never attended the Equal Justice Conference or who have not attended within the past two years.

Award:

Justice Scholarship recipients will receive up to \$750 in reimbursement for travel related expenses including: air and ground transportation, meals, and housing at the *conference* hotel (room and tax only) relative to their attendance at the Equal Justice Conference. <u>NOTE: Justice Scholarships cannot be used to pay the conference registration fee.</u>

Distribution of Award:

Scholarships will be awarded on a reimbursement basis only, following receipt of the conference evaluation, personal report, and reimbursement request form (*with original receipts*). The ABA Standing Committee on Pro Bono and Public Service will provide these forms to scholarship recipients prior to the Equal Justice Conference.

Application:
