ADMISSION TO THE NURSING PROGRAM:

Minimum admission standards include:

1. Unconditional admission to Darton State College.
2. Receipt of this completed application for the ADN program by the semester deadline.
3. Exit all required learning support courses.
4. Have earned credit on 16 or more credit hours of the general education courses required for the Darton State College Nursing program by the **June 16, 2014 deadline** (Anatomy & Physiology I and II, English 1101, College Algebra or Quantitative Skills and Reasoning strongly recommended – preference will be given to applicants who have completed both A& P I and II).
5. Minimum of 2.7 GPA (**by the June 16, 2014 deadline**) based on each attempt of credit hours for general education courses required for the Darton State College Nursing program including transferred GPA from other colleges. GPA calculation formula can be found at <http://www.darton.edu/current/fye/resources/GPA.php>
6. No previous failing grades in any nursing program.
7. Completion of the ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS ®V) (**sign up for the exam below**)
8. Meet core performance standards for admission and progression in the nursing program.
9. Hold current certificate for Paramedic or License for LPN (**attach copy**) with one (1) year of continuous work experience.

Admission to the nursing program is competitive, and the number of students is limited by the number of faculty and clinical facilities available. Meeting minimal requirements does not guarantee acceptance.

When faculty/student ratio limits the acceptance of all qualified students, preference will be given to students with the highest GPA and highest nursing pre-admission test score and have completed all required core classes.
