Woolyungah Indigenous Centre accepts the following forms of Proof of Aboriginality:

Option 1. Evidence of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent

Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander **descent** may be proved by:

A letter with "Common Seal" signed by the Chairperson of an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander incorporated organisation in which the applicant lives or has previously lived. E.g. Lands Council or Aboriginal Cultural Centre may be able to provide this for you.

Option 2. Evidence of self-identification as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander

To demonstrate **self-identification**, the individual should sign a statutory declaration that he/she is an Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander.

If you would like to make a Statutory Declaration please see the Statutory Declaration document <u>located on the next page</u>.

Option 3. Supporting letter from your school Principal or your local TAFE (if relevant)

If you identify yourself as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander and participate in such activities in your school etc, a supporting letter from your school Principal will be accepted. Additionally, if you have studied at TAFE as an Indigenous Australian, a supporting letter from TAFE will be accepted.

NOTE: Proof of receipt of Abstudy will not be accepted as Proof of Aboriginality

Option 2: Self-Identification
