

College of Nursing Institute for Natural Family Planning Online NFP Teacher Training Program

Now available as a Continuing Education Program as well as for credit!

The Institute for NFP Teacher Training program is a professional on-line educational experience based on the standards of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). The program prepares a healthcare professional to provide professional NFP services and to qualify for certification through the Diocesan Development Program for NFP (a program of the USCCB). This educational offering involves a two-course sequence that includes a 3 credit NFP Theory Course and a 3 credit NFP Supervised Practicum. Both courses can be taken for undergraduate, graduate or continuing education credit.

Heal 4200/5200: NFP Theory

Physiological, behavioral, and spiritual aspects important to teaching and using NFP

Heal 4201/5201: NFP Practicum

Practical application of theory and skills for teaching NFP and the Marquette Model. Students are assigned a personal preceptor and are required to teach a minimum of 10 new couples and present an online case study.
