Graduate Record Exam (GRE) or Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT)

You may submit GMAT scores instead of GRE scores for the MS application to the Management and Financial Engineering programs. It is strongly recommended to submit GRE scores when applying for graduate assistantships or research fellowships. GRE/GMAT scores are valid for five years from the test date. Test of English as Foreign Language (TOEFL)

The TOEFL is required for international applicants who have completed a bachelor's degree from an institution in a non-English speaking country. A score of at least 550 (written version) or 213 (CBT) is required. TOEFL scores are valid for two years from the test date. Submit your official scores to the Office of Graduate Admissions, directly from the Educational Testing Service (ETS). The Polytechnic Institute of NYU code is **2668**. *NOTE: If your TOEFL score is between 490 and 550 you can elect to take* ESL (English as a Second Language) intensive courses at NYU Poly while taking a maximum of two graduate courses per semester at the school.

Attention will be given to the listing of schools by the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET), the American Chemical Society (ACS), the Computer Science Accreditation Board (CSAB), and by the various regional accrediting associations. An applicant wishing to enter a graduate field of study different from the undergraduate field in which a bachelor's degree was earned must anticipate the possibility of taking prerequisite courses for which graduate credit may not be given.

Insurance
