### **I. FORM LIST**

With your Bill of Sale package, you will find the forms that are necessary for the transfer of ownership of an asset.

Included in your package are the following forms:

- 1. Automobile Bill of Sale and Odometer Statement
- 2. Bill of Sale for Watercraft
- 3. Bill of Sale for Mobile Home
- 4. Bill of Sale for Animal
- 5. Bill of Sale for other Personal Property

### **II. DESCRIPTIONS OF FORMS**

Brief descriptions of the forms contained in your U.S. Legal Forms™ Bill of Sale package are found below.

Automobile Bill of Sale and Odometer Statement – This Automobile Bill of Sale and Odometer Statement is a Bill of Sale that contains such information as the make/model of automobile, the VIN number and the amount the automobile is sold for. There is an odometer disclosure statement attached as required by federal and state law that requires the seller to provide mileage at transfer.

Bill of Sale for Watercraft – This Bill of Sale is for watercraft and provides buyer consideration, seller information, and a description of the boat or watercraft.

Bill of Sale for Mobile Home – This Bill of Sale is used for the sale of a mobile home. The form also provides a section for the seller to list any and all liens against the mobile home. The form must be signed in the presence of a notary public.

Bill of Sale for Animal – This Bill of Sale is used when selling an animal. A sale of animals ordinarily involves the same considerations as the sale of any other personal property. Therefore, such sales are generally governed by the provisions of the Uniform Commercial Code.

Bill of Sale for other Personal Property– Transfer of title to personal property is normally made by a bill of sale. A bill of sale also constitutes a record of what has been sold, to whom, when, and for what price.

By clicking on the appropriate form field, you will be able to enter the needed information. In some instances, the form field and the line will disappear after information is entered. In other cases, it will not. The form was created to function in this manner.
