The disclosure statement must be completed and filed with the Supreme Court, within fifteen (15) days of the notice of docketing the appeal, or concurrently by a party with the filing of a motion or other document seeking to expedite the proceedings and within two (2) days of service of such a document by all other parties. The names of all reporting parties shall be included on the form. Attach separate page or pages if additional space is needed. An original and five (5) copies of this form are to be filed. Each party shall have a continuing duty to file an amended form within 24 hours of any event affecting that party, which changes or renders incomplete any information previously disclosed.
