Illinois Law Provides:
Teachers and other employees may request any person entering a public
building or the grounds which are owned or leased by the board and used for
school purposes and activities to identify himself and the purpose of his entry. A
person who refuses to provide such information is guilty of a Class A
Misdemeanor and shall be fined not to exceed \$1,000.00 or imprisonment in an
institution other than the penitentiary. (Sec. 24-25 of Article 25 of Chapter 105 the
Illinois Compiled Statutes)
