

REVOCAATION OF DECLARATION (Living Will)

(Louisiana Revised Statutes 40:1299.58.4)

Louisiana Revised Statutes 40:1299.58.4 provides that my Declaration (Living Will) can be
revoked by me at any time by any of the following methods:

(1) By being cancelled, defaced, obliterated, burned, torn, or otherwise destroyed by the
declarant or by some person in the presence of and at the direction of the declarant.

(2)(a) By a written revocation of the declarant expressing the intent to revoke, signed and
dated by the declarant.

(b) The attending physician shall record in the patient's medical record the time and date
when
notification of the written revocation was received.

(3)(a) By an oral or nonverbal expression by the declarant of the intent to revoke the
declaration.
