AGREED TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

THIS DAY THIS CAUSE, having come on for hearing on the Petition of Plaintiffs, and , for a Temporary Restraining Order and Permanent Injunction, and the Court being advised in the premises, finds that said Petition is well taken and should be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND DECREED that a Temporary Restraining Order shall be issued pursuant to M.R.C.P. 65 against prohibiting him/her from contacting , daughter/son, , and employer, , or any employee thereof, in person, by telephone, letter or by any other means or method of communication and prohibiting him/her from coming to their home or places of business, or otherwise coming within () feet of , daughter/son, , and 's employer, , or any employee thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a Temporary Restraining Order shall be, and is, issued pursuant to M.R.C.P. 65 against prohibiting him/her from contacting in person, by telephone, letter or by any other means or method of communications and prohibiting him/her from coming to his/her home or place of business, or otherwise coming within hundred () feet of .

As allowed by M.R.C.P. 65(b) with respect to domestic relations matters, this Temporary Restraining Order is of unlimited duration. Further, as allowed by M.R.C.P. 65(c), no security is required of and because this is a domestic action.
