JUDGMENT

THIS DAY THIS ACTION CAME ON FOR HEARING on the Complaint for Injunction filed by , and the Court having received testimony and documentary evidence finds as follows:

1. This Court has jurisdiction of the parties and of the subject matter.
2. Pursuant to the Meeting of Membership of , on , 20 and pursuant to the Stipulation entered into by , a meeting of the membership of was held on , 20 to vote as to whether Rev. should remain or be discharged as Pastor of said Church.
3. A majority of the membership of said Church voted that Rev. should be discharged as Pastor.
4. Said Complaint for Injunction is well taken and the relief stated herein below should be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. Rev. is discharged as Pastor of .
2. Rev. is prohibited and enjoined from entering upon the premises of .
3. Rev. is prohibited and enjoined from acting in any pastoral capacity for .
4. The Chancery Clerk of County, Mississippi shall immediately tender and pay to all remaining funds tendered into the Registry of the Court in connection with this action.
