II. DESCRIPTIONS OF FORMS

Brief descriptions of the forms contained in your U.S. Legal Forms[™] Personal Planning Package are found below.

Contract for the Sale and Purchase of Commercial Real Estate – Lot or Land – This form is a Contract for the Sale and Purchase of Real Estate. The form requires information such as: property condition, earnest money, and utilities.

Option for the Sale and Purchase of a Commercial Building

This form provides a buyer with an exclusive and irrevocable option to purchase residential real estate, specifically a commercial building.

Option for the Sale and Purchase of a Commercial Lot or Land

This form provides a buyer with an exclusive and irrevocable option to purchase residential real estate, specifically a commercial lot or piece of land.

Addendum for Environmental Assessment of Threatened or Endangered Species or Wetlands

This form is an Environmental Assessment, Endangered Species, and Wetlands Addendum to a Real Estate Contract, wherein the parties agree that inspections and assessments related to the subject matter may be made by buyer prior to closing the contract, and that buyer may terminate contract if associated problems are discovered.

Addendum for Continued Marketing of Property by Seller due to Contingencies

This form is an Addendum to a Residential Real Estate Sales Contract allowing for the continued marketing of the subject property by the seller while seller completes the process of fulfilling certain contingencies. If another offer is received on the property, seller must notify the buyer that a new offer has been received, and that buyer must waive the contingencies or else property may be sold to new offeror. Adapt to fit your specific circumstances as desired.

An Exchange Addendum to Contract for Tax Free Exchange under Section 1031

This form is used when there is a tax free exchange proposed for buyer or seller.

A Tax Free Exchange Agreement pursuant to Section 1031

This is a multi-state form covering the subject matter of: Tax Free Exchange Agreements for Section 1031 of the Internal Revenue Code. This is the same as a simultaneous exchange agreement

A Fixed Rate Promissory Note Secured by Commercial Real Estate

This is a Promissory Note for use where commercial property is security for the loan. A separate deed of trust or mortgage is also required.
