

REVOCATION OF DECLARATION

(Wyoming Statutes 35-22-103)

Wyoming Statutes 35-22-103 provides that a Declaration (Living Will) can be revoked by me at any time by any of the following methods:

- (i) Being obliterated, burned, torn or otherwise destroyed or defaced in a manner indicating intention to cancel; or
- (ii) A written revocation of the declaration signed and dated by the declarant or person acting at the direction of the declarant; or
- (iii) A verbal expression of the intent to revoke the declaration, in the presence of an adult witness who signs and dates a writing confirming that the expression of intent was made. Any verbal revocation is effective upon receipt by the attending physician of the above mentioned writing.
