







Riverina Red Gums

Expressing cultural attachment through art

About the Project

The project seeks to actively involve Aboriginal people to express their artistic cultural connection to the new Riverina red gum reserves (national & regional parks). The project is funded by the NSW Government, Office of Environment & Heritage - Aboriginal Park Partnership Funding Program. Aboriginal Artists will be chosen based upon criteria that will include examples of existing works. The artists will be invited to produce a final work for submission to be exhibited at various art galleries across the Riverina red gum region.

Exhibition Brief

To create an artwork expressing Aboriginal cultural connection to the Riverina red gum reserves in any medium and any size. Aboriginal artists will be selected to participate in the exhibition by successfully completing this expression of interest form. A selection panel (up to 4 people) will select proposals which best reflect the artists story/connection to the Riverina red gum reserves. Selected artists will be required to participate in a workshop to assist in the development of their final work on 25th and 26th June 2011. The final exhibition will be launched at Griffith Regional Art Gallery in May 2012 and will tour to Mildura, Deniliquin and Echuca.

Selection Criteria

Aboriginal artists will be selected based on (but not limited to) the following selection criteria

- currently practising in the visual arts field
- previous art making experience
- · professional presentation of work
- examples of previous work (photographs)
- experience creating artworks for exhibition/ sale

Artworks restricted to painting, sculpture, mixed media, photography, drawing and illustration.

- Artist create NEW works for exhibition June-November 2011
- Final artworks completed November 2011

- Judging of final works and exhibition at Griffith Regional Art Gallery May 2012
- Exhibition tours to Mildura, Deniliquin & Echuca June/July 2012


