

COMPETITION DETAILS

Welcome to the PTA's first ever photo calendar competition! Our hope is to produce an annual calendar celebrating all the creativity, diversity and beauty of

the St. Andrew's School community. This year's calendar will highlight the learner profiles and themes of the IB programme, with a different school theme or IB Learner Profile attribute featured each month.

Photographic entries may be of any subject (animate or inanimate), or scene, illustrating one of the IB Learner Profiles or School Themes. A chart of these has been provided for your reference overleaf. Photos of original artwork may be submitted, provided that such photos meet all specifications as laid out in the Contest Rules. We encourage you to submit interesting, vibrant entries that demonstrate what your chosen theme or profile means to you!

CONTEST RULES

- 1. The St. Andrew's School PTA Calendar Photo Competition is open to all members of the St. Andrew's School community and the community at large: students and parents, faculty and staff, family and friends.
- 2. Photographs may be of any subject or scene that in some way illustrates, portrays or represents one of the IB Learner Profiles or School Themes listed in the table overleaf.
- 3. **DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES IS TUESDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2011**. All entries are submitted at the owner's risk and will not be returned.
- All entries are to be delivered to Mrs. Mary Turner in the school's Front Office. Entries may be delivered at any time during school hours. Envelopes should be marked "PTA Calendar Contest".
- 5. All entries must be accompanied by a **completed entry form**, as well as **a one-time \$5.00 entry fee**. Forms may be photocopied as necessary for additional entries. Cheques should be made out to the St. Andrew's PTA.
- 6. All entries must be supplied with 8"x10" prints which will be used in the judging process. Images must be also be provided as digital files on CD. Digital images must be of high quality (2700 x 2100 pixels or larger). To ensure the best image reproduction, digital images should be supplied in RAW, TIFF or high quality JPEG and in the original format the camera uses (LAB or RGB). (Note: prints submitted without CD's will not be eligible and vice versa). The photographer's name, photo subject and location, and theme/attribute represented must be written on the reverse of the print.
- 7. Judging of entries will be based on attractiveness, interest, composition, adherence to theme, originality and quality of photograph. The photographs selected will appear in the St. Andrew's School PTA's 2012 wall calendar. The decision of the judges will be final.
- 8. **Prizes will be awarded** for each of the photographs selected. Photographic credits will be given in the calendar. The number of entries per photographer is limited to a maximum of 10 photos.

- 9. The winning photographs, along with all publication and reproduction rights attached thereto, become the property of St. Andrew's School, and the School reserves the right to use such in the future. **Photos will not be returned.**
- 10. Photos must be the original work of the photographer. Previously published photos are not eligible.

PLEASE NOTE THAT WE CANNOT CONSIDER ENTRIES THAT:

- Are submitted after the deadline
- Do not have the photographer's name, photo subject and location, and attribute represented by photo written on the reverse of the photo
- Are submitted without the CD
- · Are submitted with the CD only and no printed photograph
- Are poorly produced (must be RAW, TIFF or high quality JPEG) in the original format the camera uses (LAB or RGB)
- Are not accompanied by a completed entry form and the \$5.00 fee
- Prints are smaller than 8" x 10"
