



INITIAL WEBSITE DOCUMENT PROVIDER REGISTRATION

Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 84-2.2, all persons, firms, or companies that operate a website that offers consumers access to interactive software that generates a legal document based on the consumer's answers to questions presented by the software that complies with the requirements of the statute must register with the North Carolina State Bar before commencing operation in North Carolina.

Registration does not constitute approval by the North Carolina State Bar. The operation of the website must comply with all pertinent laws, including the prohibition on the unauthorized practice of law in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 84-2.1-10. Registration does not constitute agreement or acquiescence by the State Bar that the operation of the website complies with all laws including N.C. Gen. Stat. § 84-2.1 or 2.2.

A website provider must file an initial registration with the State Bar and must renew the registration annually. The initial registration fee is \$100. The annual renewal fee is \$50.

The consumer satisfaction process must be conspicuously displayed on the provider's website.
