<u>Transportation</u>: Transportation to and from the Day Camp site is the responsibility of the parents. Car pools are encouraged and are part of the fun.

<u>Uniforms</u>: Camp uniform (for Scouts and staff) is the camp T-shirt. One shirt is included in the cost for every camper; full-week volunteers will be issued two free shirts. Additional shirts may be purchased. These shirts will be given out upon arrival on Monday and must be worn every day of camp. Comfortable shoes are a must. NO opentoed shoes, flip-flops, or sandals. Be prepared: this is a rain or shine event.

<u>Please send your child with a refillable water bottle</u>. Lunch is scheduled around noon each day, will last approximately 30 minutes, and then be followed by some type of `quiet time activity_ which usually lasts approximately 30 minutes. Any parent is welcome to check in for lunch with their child, but all campers are to remain in camp during lunch.

<u>Health Forms</u>: All Camp participants (youth and adults) MUST submit a current BSA medical form (Parts A and B). <u>PLEASE MAIL THE COMPLETED MEDICAL FORM WITH THIS REGISTRATION</u> (don't forget to attach a copy of your health insurance card). If there are compelling reasons this is not possible, the completed medical form <u>must</u> be turned in Monday morning (August 1) upon arrival at camp. Scouts will not be allowed to remain in camp without this form. A Camp Health Officer will be on hand for first aid (not medical treatment) and to oversee the administration of any medications needed during day camp hours.
