Use extra paper where necessary. **Applications must be postmarked no later than midnight March 26, 2016.** Email entries will not be accepted. All applications become the property of the Pocumtuc Lodge and will not be returned to the applicant. Handwritten applications will NOT be accepted.

Requirements

- 1) Be a member in good standing of the Pocumtuc Lodge (i.e. Lodge dues paid and registered with a local Troop/Crew).
- 2) Be a graduating high school senior or an undergraduate college student under age 21 on 1/31/2015. Must be attending an accredited 2-year, 4-year or vocational school.
- 3) Provide two (2) letters of recommendation attesting to the general character of the applicant and highlighting service to others where possible. Letters from relatives are not acceptable.
- 4) Provide an official transcript from your school.

Scholarship awards will be presented at the Annual Lodge Banquet on April 24th. Scholarship recipients are strongly encouraged to attend.
