Any work undertaken by the Vendorprior to the effective date shall be at his sole risk and, in the event that the contract shall not become effective, the State shall be underno obligation to reimburse the Vendorfor any such work.
- 4. CONTRACT PRICE The contract price, a payment schedule and a maximum limitation of price shall be as specified by the bid invitation and the Vendor's bid. All payments shall be conditioned upon receipt, and approval by the State, of appropriate vouchers and upon satisfactory performance by the Vendor, as determined by the State. The payment by the State of the Contract Price shall constitute complete reimbursement to the Vendor for all expenses of any nature incurred by the Vendor in the performance by the Vendor and complete payment for the Services. The State shall have no other liability to the Vendor.
- 5. DELIVERY. If the vendor fails to furnish items and/or services in accordance with all requirements, including delivery, the state may repurchase similar items from any other source without competitive bidding, and the original vendormay be liable to the state for any excess costs. If a vendor is unable to complete delivery by the date specified, he must contact the using agency. However, the agency is not required to accept a delay to the original delivery date. All deliveries are subject to inspection and receiving procedure rules as established by the State of New Hampshire. Deliveries are not considered accepted until compliance with the serules has been established. State personnel signatures on shipping documents shall signify only the receipt of shipments. - **6. INVO IC ING.** All invoices must be in triplicate showing Order Number, Unit and Extension Prices and discounts allowed. A separate invoice shall be submitted for each order. Unless otherwise noted on the invitation to bid or purchase order, payment will not be due until thirty (30) days after all services have been completed, or all items have been delivered, inspected and accepted or the invoice has been received at the agency business office, which ever is later. The state shall not be charged or make late payment fees for products or service rendered. Invoices may be faxed or emailed to the agency remit address

#### 7. PERSONNEL

- 7.1. The Vendor shall disc lose in writing the names of all owners (5% or more), directors, officers, employees, agents or subcontractors who are also officials or employees of the State of New Hampshire. Any change in this information shall be reported in writing within fifteen (15) days of their occurrence.
- 7.2. The person signing this agreement on behalf of the State, or his or her delegee ("Contracting Officer") shall be the State's representative for purposes of this agreement. In the event of any dispute concerning the interpretation of this agreement, the Contracting Officer's decision shall be final.

### 8. EVENTOF DEFAULT, REMEDIES.

- 8.1. Any one ormore of the following acts or omissions of the Vendorshall constitute an event of default here under ("Events of Default"):
- 8.1.1. failure to de liver the goods or services satisfac to rily or on schedule; or
- 8.1.2. failure to submit any report required here under, or

- 8.2.2. give the Vendora written notice specifying the Event of Default and suspending all payments to be made under this agreement and ordering that the portion of the Contract Price, which would otherwise accrue to the Vendorduring the period from the date of such notice until such time as the State determines that the Vendorhas cured the Event of Default, shall never be paid to the Vendor; and 8.2.3. set off against any other obligation the State may owe to the Vendorany damages the State suffers by reason of any Event of Default; and
- **8.2.4.** treat the agreement as breached and pursue any of its remedies at law or in equity, or both.
- 9. WAIVER OF BREACH. No failure by the State to enforce any provisions here of after any Event of Default shall be deemed a waiver of its rights with regard to that Event, or any subsequent Event. No express failure of any Event of Default shall be deemed a waiver of any provision hereof. No such failure or waiver shall be deemed a waiver of the right of the State to enforce each and all of the provisions hereof upon any further or other default on the part of the Vendor.
- 10. VENDOR'S RELATION TO THE STATE. In the performance of this agreement the Vendor is in all respects an independent contractor, and is neither an agent nor an employee of the State. Neither the Vendor nor any of its officers, employees, agents or members shall have authority to bind the State nor are they entitled to any of the benefits, workmen's compensation or emoluments provided by the State to its employees.
- 11. ASSIGNMENTAND SUBCONTRACTS. The Vendor shall not assign, or otherwise transfer any interest in this agreement without the prior written consent of the State.

  No work required by this contract shall be subcontracted without the prior written consent of the State.
- 12. INDEMNIFICATION. The contractor shall defend, indemnify and hold hamless the State, its officers and employees, from and against any and all losses suffered by the State, its officers and employees, and any and all claims, liabilities or penalties asserted against the State, its officers and employees, by or on behalf of any person, on account of, based on, resulting from, arising out of (or which may be claimed to arise out of) the acts or omissions of the Vendor. Not with standing the foregoing, nothing here in contained shall be deemed to constitute a waiver of the sovereign immunity of the State, which immunity is here by reserved to the State. This covenant shall survive the termination of this agreement.
