UNIT TOURNAMENT COORDINATOR RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Complete the team and tee assignments sheet listing names all of player, their handicap and club rental requirements. It is recommended that each team have at least one experienced golfer to act as the team captain. The Pro Shop will assign golf cart numbers to be used. The completed list will be presented to the Pro Shop for payment no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the tournament. (See Attachment 1)

2. Inform all participants they must check in 30 minutes prior to their start time and attend a mandatory briefing on golf etiquette, which will be presented by the Unit Tournament Coordinator prior to start time.

3. Designate a person to perform marshal duties during the tournament. Marshal is required to ensure the safety of players, greens, equipment, and ensure players observe and comply with the mandatory playing time of five hours. Any loss or damage to rental equipment or course must be reported to the Pro Shop for individual or unit recuperation/ payment. The individual who used the cart is responsible for it. However, the unit tournament coordinator will be responsible for recuperation/ payment for any abuse/ damage that cannot be attributed to a particular individual. Only individuals with a valid driver's license are allowed to operate power carts. Units which take longer than five hours will be asked to stop playing and continue with the award ceremony.

4. Food and beverages must be purchased from the dubhouse. Snack Bar services will be available. Additionally, a special food and beverage plan is available for unit tournaments.

I certify that all golf cart operators will possess a valid driver's license. All persons operating carts will be held liable for any act of negligence that results in an accident or causes bodily injury or damage to property. Failure to operate carts IAW the above, all posted rules on cart operation, following cart paths, and observing golf course etiquette, will result in the operator being suspended from using the carts and forfeiture of any monies previously paid on the cart. I agree to leave an ID card as a deposit for each cart key. Failure to return a key will result in a \$5.00 fee. UNIT TOURNAMENT BRIEFING TOPICS

1. DRESS CODE: Only soft spikes/ spike less golf shoe or smooth sole tennis shoes may be worn on the golf course.

2. Out-off shorts (male and female), tank tops, halter tops and BDU's are prohibited. Shirts and blouses will be worn at all times.

3. POWER CARTS: Carts should be kept at least 30 feet from greens and tees. Only two riders per cart. No horseplay, racing, ramming, power braking, or abuse of the course or equipment.

4. ICE CHESTS/ COOLERS: Ice chests and coolers are not permitted on the course. Only beverages purchased at the Clubhouse or through the beverage cart are permitted.

5. CHILDREN: Children under seven years of age are not permitted on the course.

6. MAKING THE TURN (9TH & 10TH HOLE): Players stopping for more than five minutes after playing #9 lose position and right of play. This also applies in cases of shotgun, 1st & 10th Tee starts, when players pass by dubhouse. You have a maximum of five hours to finish, but, please encourage a faster finish. Keep up with the group in front of you, and obey local rules/ policies.

7. RANGE BALLS: Range balls are for use on the range only. DO NOT USE THEM ON THE COURSE.

8. DIVOTS AND BALL MARKS: Replace all divots and repair all ball marks on the greens. Rake the sand bunker after your shot.

9. Do not play a ball from areas marked "Ground Under Repair" or "Winter Greens".

10. In case of inclement weather, especially when lightning is present, discontinue play and take cover until it has passed.

SCRAMBLE FORMAT: Method of Play.

1. All players hit from the tee.

2. The team captain selects the ball in the best position from which all players will hit their next shots.

3. This will continue until the ball is holed.

4. If any player intentionally/ accidentally taps a short putt into the hole before all others have had a chance to putt, then this automatically ends play for that hole, and that score must be recorded.

5. Only one ball will be used to record the team score.

6. Each team should have a player with some golfing experience. The player with the most experience should be designated as team captain. The team captain's responsibility is to ensure others in the group adhere to all rules and policies, i.e., carts, playing with range balls, slow play, and damage to the course.
