	Detailed description of planned learning experience, duration, scope and merits of experience Statement of expected benefits, value and relevance to future craft practice. A completed and balanced budget to show applicable costs, which may include such things as travel, tuition, books, materials, living expenses and all anticipated sources of funding. Images and descriptions of relevant craft work if you or your group has not previously been juried by The Craft Council of Newfoundland and Labrador. A complete résumé, to include previous craft training and work experience. Describe craft-related experience whether as an employee, volunteer or self-employed craftsperson Two letters of reference, one of which may be a character reference and the other of which must be professional. A portfolio demonstrating previous work, containing images of a minimum of four pieces of work. Provide ar information list, describing each item, and giving size, materials and techniques used, and the date of completion. Self-directed study applications must demonstrate that the experience will meet the expectations of the applicant. To address this point, applicants may include as appropriate, such things as credentials of instructor or mentor, research materials to be consulted, descriptions of equipment and materials to be used, etc.
