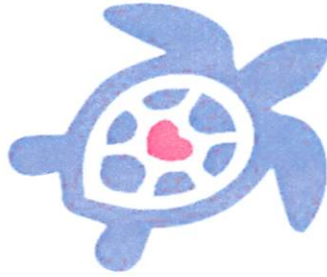
WEEK 6: ARTISTS ALL AROUND, COMING HOMEWARD BOUND!
