- □ Presentation approval by staff in mid-September for Fall semester or mid-February for Spring semester (optional).
- \Box Attend meeting offered once a semester.
- □ Make presentations to K-12 students, and campus audiences including residence halls, student organizations, the Annual Study Abroad Fair, selected classes, special events, etc.
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□Other duties as assigned or as suggested by you!

- □ A positive attitude, enthusiasm for study abroad, and a willingness to share your international experience with interested students.
- □ Ability to use oral and written communication effectively and creatively.
