We look forward to providing your child with an enjoyable and safe experience. *IF YOU HAVE SIGNED UP CHILDREN OTHER THAN OWN – PLEASE BE SURE TO FORWARD THIS INFORMATION ON TO THEIR PARENT/GUARDIAN.* Please read the following information carefully:

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WHAT FORMS DO I NEED TO FILL OUT FOR MY CHILD?

- □ There are three forms that must be completed and mailed to address on top of form.
- □ A form must be completed for each child registered.
- □ Campers must have their forms on file before participating in the camp.
- □ It is ok to list multiple Dorbrook camps on one form. One camp form required per camper.
- □ The mailing for these forms is sorted by address. If you signed up multiple children please copy the form and give them this information.
- □ Additional medical paperwork may be required if your child has a medical condition that may require special care or medication while the child is at camp.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING TO CAMP?

All of the necessary sports equipment is provided by the park system, but you are more than welcome to bring your own equipment to camp. Your child will be outdoors for the majority of the camp day. Please be aware, if you choose to bring your own equipment, the park system is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged equipment. We strongly discourage children from bringing any toys from home. Please be sure to clearly label all equipment.

The following items should be sent with your child each day:

- → Light colored, comfortable clothing.
- Sneakers No sandals, flip flops, Crocs or any open toed shoes.
- ➔ Water Bottle
- → Lunch (Full Day Camps Only)
- ➔ Snack (Half Day Camps)

- ➔ Sunscreen
 - → Bathing Suit & Towel (please mark with your child's name)
 - Kindercraze, Pioneers, Triple Treasures, Sportscraze, Camp Dorbrook, and Buccaneers swim daily.
 - Wizarding Games, Camp Half-Blood, Pixie Hollow, Avengers Assemble, Star Wars, Frozen, Princess Party Camp swim at least two days of the week.
 - Basketball, Soccer, Baseball, Hockey, and Field Hockey will swim once per week.
 You will be notified of the exact day and time your child will be swimming.
 - Camps may have the opportunity to visit our Sprayground also.

Due to the increase in the number of individuals who have nut allergies, we are requesting that you please do not send in food or snacks to camps with nuts, peanut oil or nut byproducts.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT FOR SPORTS CAMPS:

➔ Roller Hockey

• Inline skates, knee pads, elbow pads, helmet, stick. Most equipment available to borrow for program. We do not have any inline skates.

➔ Field Hockey

• Shin guards, goggles, and mouth guard

OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT FOR SPORTS CAMPS:

- → Baseball/T-Ball: glove, cleats, bat, batting glove
- ➔ Roller Hockey: gloves
- ➔ Soccer/Basketball: ball, shin guards
- ➔ Flag Football: cleats
- ➔ Field Hockey: stick
- → Surfing/Board Riders: Board, rash guard, helmet

PLEASE MARK ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR CHILD'S FULL NAME. IF AN ITEM IS MISPLACED, PLEASE NOTIFY US IMMEDIATELY.

WHERE DOES MY CHILD'S CAMP MEET?

To help insure your child is at the right camp, please bring your receipt with you on the first day of camp.

Please drop off your child at the Dorbrook Park location indicated below (see enclosed map):

- Soccer PICNIC TABLES BY BASKETBALL COURTS
- Full Day Camps (Pioneers, Buccaneers (week of 7/1), Triple Treasures, Camp Half Blood Wizarding Games): GREEN TENT IN FRONT OF VISITOR CENTER (TENT 2)
- Image: Half Day Camps (Kindercraze, Sports Craze, Avengers Assemble, Pixie Hollow) GREEN TENT NEXT TO HORSESHOE PITS (TENT 1.)
- Camp Dorbrook/Buccaneers (week of 8/11)Five For One Sports Camp/Powder Puff Sports: Shelter building near basketball courts
- Field Hockey Field Hockey fields near Activity Center parking lot
- Roller/Floor Hockey– Shelter near basketball courts
- Basketball Shelter near basketball courts
- Flag Football Football field on South side of Route 537 (Entrance directly opposite the Dorbrook main entrance)
- Board Riders/Surfs Up/Camp Seven Presidents- Pavilion at <u>Seven Presidents Park</u> (Same Shelter as concession stand.)
- Camp Thompson- Lawn in front of Creative Arts Center at <u>Thompson Park</u>

PLEASE BE PROMPT WHEN PICKING UP AND DROPPING OFF YOUR CHILD. ALSO, YOU, OR WHOEVER IS DROPPING OFF/PICKING UP YOUR CHILD MUST SIGN IN AND SIGN OUT EACH DAY. OUR STAFF HAS BEEN INSTRUCTED NOT TO RELEASE OR ACCEPT A CHILD WHO HAS NOT HAD A PARENT OR DESIGNATED ADULT SIGN THEM IN AND OUT. PLEASE PARK IN THE DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS OR THE RANGERS WILL TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTIONS.

WHAT HAPPENS IF IT RAINS?

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING WHEN IT IS RAINING THE MORNING OF YOUR CAMP:

- Kindercraze, Triple Treasures, Pioneers, Sportscraze, Wizarding Games, Camp Half Blood, Pixie Hollow, Star Wars, Avengers Assemble, Camp Dorbrook, Camp Thompson, Princess Party Camp, Frozen, and Buccaneers will be held rain or shine. Alternate indoor activities will be planned in the event of bad weather.
 - Roller/Floor Hockey, Basketball, Soccer, Field Hockey, Flag Football, Baseball, T-Ball, Powder Puff Sports Camp, Surfs Up, Board Riders and Four for One and Five for One Camps are all CANCELLED in the event of bad weather prior to the camp's starting time. If it begins to rain once a camp has begun alternate indoor activities will be planned.

Pick-up for any camps moved indoors may be at the Dorbrook Visitor Center.

If at any time you are unsure as to whether your camp will be held, please our call our weather cancellation number at 732-842-4000 ext. 6. A recorded message will be in place ONE HOUR prior to the camp's starting time. If your camp IS NOT listed on the message, it is running as scheduled.
