New Requirement for UGA: Following a five-year pilot process that allowed two-year and state colleges to admit students without requiring standardized tests the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia has changed the policy to require standardized test scores for 2011 and beyond. The University System of Georgia has a minimum score requirement: State Universities require SAT scores of at least 430 on Critical Reading and 400 on Math OR a score of 17 on Math and English on the ACT.




