Wizard of Oz—FPFATA—General Rules & Information

- All cast members and parents of those cast members 18 and under should plan on attending the cast meeting/first rehearsal on Monday, June 13, 2016. Parents will meet separately from cast and will be excused at 7:45. Rehearsal will go from 6:30-9:30 pm.
- Rehearsals will be held Monday through Thursday evening on a scene by scene schedule beginning June 13th. All lead roles should expect to attend more rehearsals than others. Other cast members should plan on at least 2 evenings per week. Last 2-3 weeks will be full cast rehearsals Monday-Thursday.
- A rehearsal schedule will be distributed as soon as it is finalized.
- Tech week is **MANDATORY** no rehearsals can be missed during this week for any reason or understudies will do performances. Tech week dates are July 18th, 19th & 20th with performances July 21st, 22nd & 23rd.
- A participation fee will be collected at script pickup. Fees are \$35 for current members whose membership was paid by April 30, 2016; \$75 for non-members or those whose membership is paid after April 30, 2015. NO SCRIPT/MUSIC will be distributed without payment.
- This is a family organization with participants of all ages from 6-adult. No drinking, drugs or vulgar language will be tolerated during rehearsals or performances. Immediate dismissal is possible for violating this rule.

Please note: If you are a parent of a child 12 and under we are asking that you commit to assist with supervision at rehearsals. This will include helping to monitor younger children so rehearsals can continue without distraction. A schedule will be distributed and parents may sign up for selected times. (Should be no more than 2-3 rehearsals).

ALL families are asked to provide at least 1 volunteer during the performances to help with ticket sales, backstage/dressing room supervision, raffle ticket sales, concession sales, programs, clean up, door greeters just to name a few. This allows us to keep our participation fees low, otherwise they would be much higher.

We also need volunteers to assist with set building / painting, pre-show ticket sales, publicity, stage crew, costumes, etc. Please watch for sign up lists and make sure to jump in and help! Thank you.
