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#### Governmental Affairs of PBA - Glace Ahead

**Data Quality** (Chair - Bill Mullray) – Senate Bill 263, prime sponsor Sen. Edwin Erickson (R-Delaware), amends the Regulatory Review Act to make sure state agencies use acceptable data in developing new regulations. On April 12, the Senate State Government Committee reported SB 263 to the full Senate without objection, and task force chairman Bill Mullray testified on the need for a "Data Quality Act" at a hearing on regulatory reform held April 26 by the Pennsylvania House Majority Policy Committee. This legislation has been on our priority watch list for the past 3 sessions. It passed the Senate in both of those sessions and is looking to do so this session. However, it never made it through the House because Gov. Rendell had threatened to veto. Hopefully Gov. Corbett will be more supportive.

Home Improvement Contractor Fix-it legislation (Chair – Jim Conner) – HB 1336 (Rep. Godshall). This legislation has been introduced. This is identical to Sen. Tomlinson's legislation from last session – which would improve the act for retailers, contractor and consumers. The act became law in 2008 – and requires all contractors who perform at least \$5,000 in home improvements each year, register with the Attorney General's office. This bill (HB 1336) would make 3 major changes – it would require that the fees that are collected by the Attorney General for registration, be placed into a dedicated fund to administer and enforce the act (currently it goes to the general fund). It would also set the one-third maximum deposit for contracts valued at \$5,000 (an increase from \$1,000) which has been proven to be unreasonably low. Finally the legislation defines "home improvement retailer" in order to allow retail installers of all sizes, the option to opt out of the 1/3 partial pay – and allow them to collect 100% of the cost if they post a letter of credit in the amount of \$100,000 per store location. A vote is scheduled in the House Consumer Affairs Committee on May 4. PBA has done a memo to the House requesting co-sponsors and to the committee members in support of passage in the committee.
