The GED Scholarship is available to eligible candidates wishing to take the General Educational Development Tests (GED®). In order to retain your scholarship, you must register for eligible parts of the GED Tests within 60 days of issuance of the scholarship and take the Test(s) at any Southern Crescent Technical College Adult Education site. If you do not show up for testing on the date for which you registered, your scholarship will be void. Scholarship monies cannot be applied to retesting fees.

Your application will be reviewed by the scholarship committee. Please allow two-three weeks for processing.

GED® Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

A GED® candidate is eligible to apply for a GED Scholarship if he/she meets the following criteria:

1. The candidate must be attending Southern Crescent Technical College Adult Education classes in Butts, Fayette, Henry, Jasper, Lamar, Pike, Spalding, Taylor, or Upson counties.
2. The candidate must obtain a level completion OR must be an EFL 6 with a minimum of 12 contact hours.
3. * To be eligible for a scholarship for individual tests, the candidate must have the following minimum scores on the GED Ready Test:

- a. SOCIAL STUDIES: 155
- b. SCIENCE: 152
- c. MATH: 154
- d. READING/LANGUAGE ARTS: 152

Scholarships may be awarded to single sub-tests. Instructors must attach a copy of the score sheet with the scholarship application. GED Ready scores are good for one semester only.

4. The candidate must affirm that he or she has a financial need and might not otherwise be able to take the GED Test without financial assistance.
5. The candidate agrees to sign a release giving the Adult Education Division at Southern Crescent Technical College permission to provide the College with any additional information that may be needed in order to process the GED Testing Scholarship application.
6. Candidate must be in good standing with the discipline code at Southern Crescent Technical College.
7. Candidate must complete the scholarship application packet and receive the recommendation from his or her instructor for the scholarship.
8. Candidate is only eligible for a scholarship one time in each of the 4 test areas.
9. The GED Tests must be taken at a Southern Crescent Technical College Official GED Testing Center.

Once the candidate has met the above mentioned criteria and has completed the scholarship application, the instructor must sign and submit the completed application to the Program Administrator along with a printout from GALIS verifying level completion or level 6 enrollment. The decision on the application will be disclosed to the candidate within two-three weeks of the submission date.

*GED Ready Vouchers are distributed to each county based on enrollment and availability. To be considered for available vouchers, a student must meet criteria 1, 2 and 6. GED Ready

Vouchers can only be administered to a single student, once every 6 months. GED Ready Tests are available for public purchase, but privately purchased GED Ready Tests cannot be used to earn SCTC GED Scholarships.
